Rom. 15:7, "Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God.

He does not say, 'And to seeds,' as of many, but as of one, 'And to your Seed,' who is Christ." Rom. 15:9, "and that the Gentiles might glorify God for His mercy, as it is written: 'For this reason I will <u>confess</u> to You among the Gentiles, and sing to Your name.'"
