Doctrine of Suffering for Blessing

1. Every believer goes through tests.

A test is any situation where we choose to either sin or obey the Word; react through mental attitude sins: anger, lust, resentment, jealousy, bitterness—or sins of the tongue: gossip, maligning, lying, deception—or overt sins.

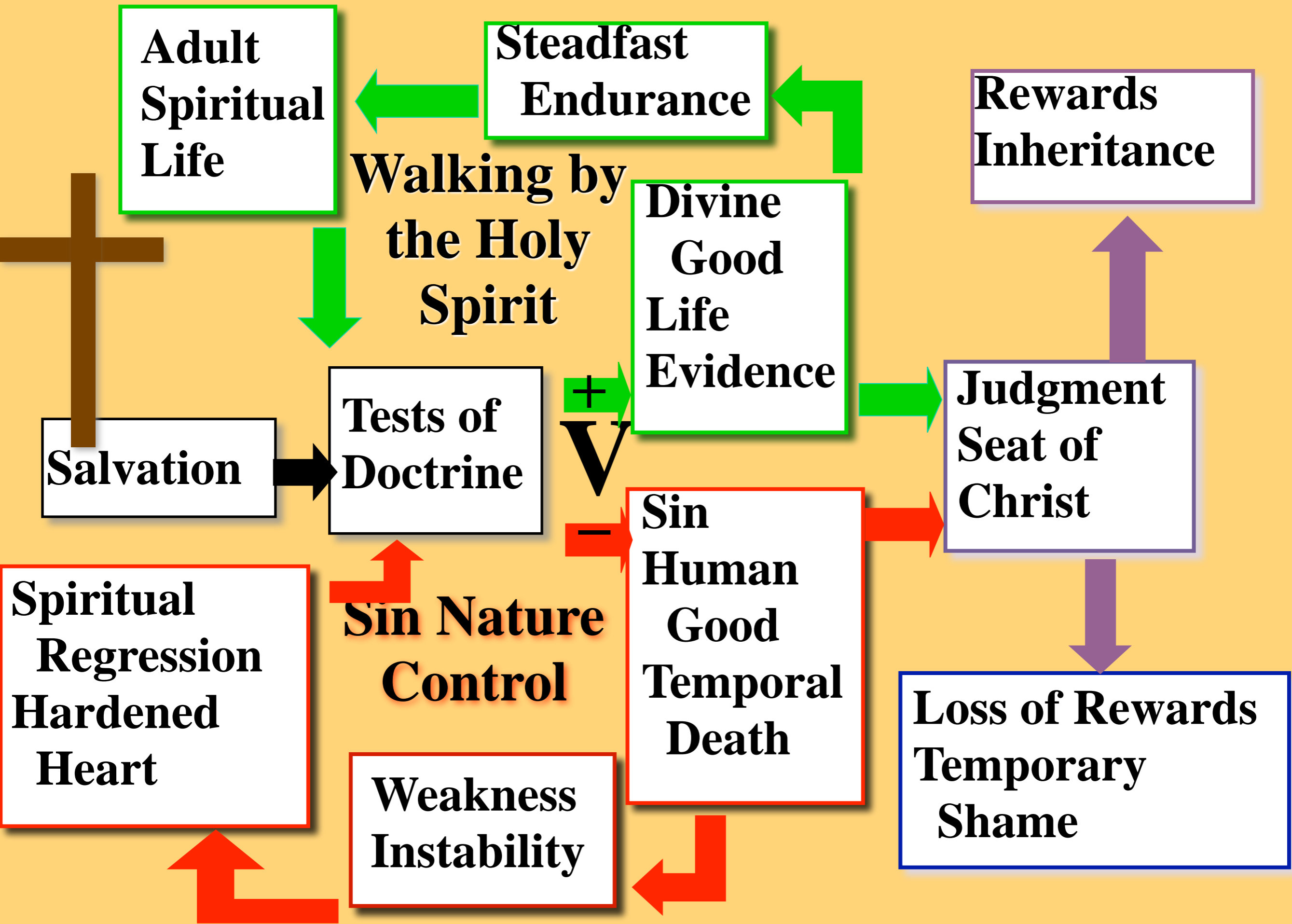

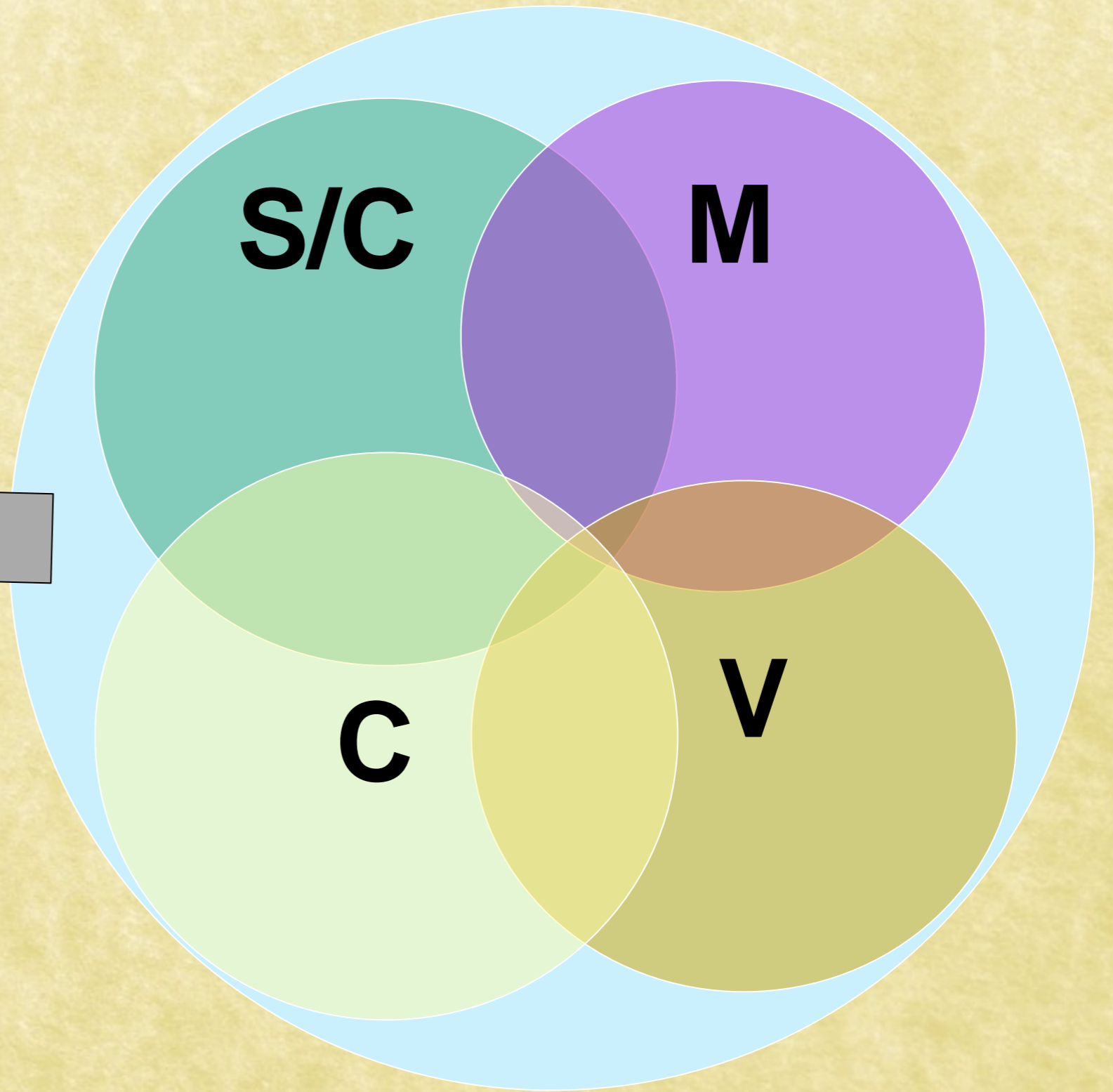
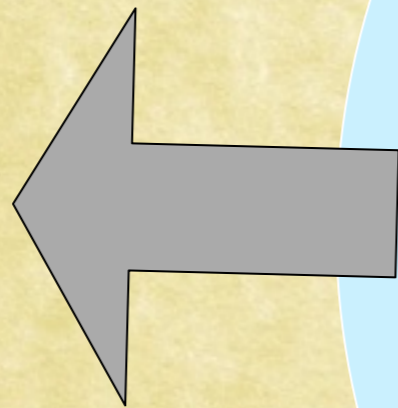

Verses related to the Problem

Prov. 23:7, “For as he thinks in his soul, so is he.”

Prov. 12:25, “Anxiety in the heart of man causes depression, But a good word makes it glad.”

Verses related to the Solution

Deut. 6:6, “And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart.

Deut. 6:7, “You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.

Deut. 6:8, “You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes.”

Verses related to the Solution

Psa. 77:12, “I will also meditate on all Your work, And talk of Your deeds.”

Prov. 6:21, “Bind them continually upon your heart; Tie them around your neck.”

Verses related to the Solution

Psa. 1:1, “Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;

Psa. 1:2, “But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night.

Psa. 1:3, “He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.”

הגה *hagah*

“to meditate, moan, speak, whisper, murmur.”

In meditation it likely refers to someone saying something over and over again as they focus their thinking.

Psa. 2:1, “Why are the nations in an uproar and the peoples devising a vain thing?”

Verses related to the Solution

Psa. 63:6, “When I remember You on my bed, I meditate on You in the night watches.”

Psa. 143:5, “I remember the days of old; I meditate on all Your doings; I muse [*shiach*] on the work of Your hands.”

Psa. 104:34, “May my meditation be sweet to Him; I will be glad in the LORD.”

שִׁיתָ (s'îah) I, *meditate, muse, commune, speak, complain.*

Phil. 4:8, “Finally, brethren, whatever things are true [*alethes*], whatever things are noble [*semna* honorable, consistent with God’s character], whatever things are just [consistent with God’s integrity], whatever things are pure [morally unstained], whatever things are lovely [acceptable, pleasing to God], whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue [moral excellence] and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.”
