Hailstones and coals of fire.**

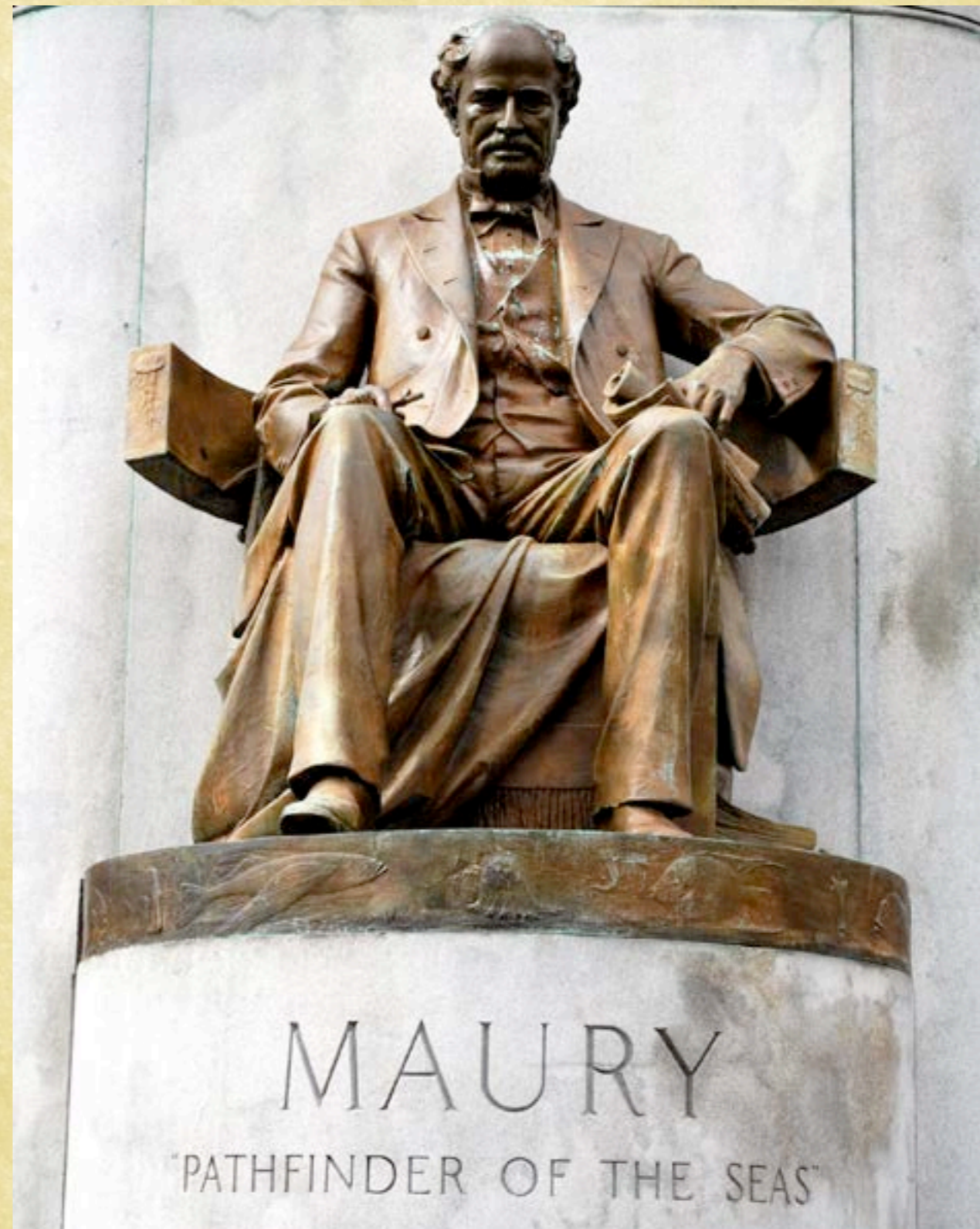
