

### 1 Pet. 1:1, "Peter, <u>an apostle of Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u>,


To the pilgrims of the Dispersion in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia,

1 Pet. 1:2, "<u>elect according to the</u> <u>foreknowledge</u> of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace be multiplied." elect

according to the foreknowledge of God the **Father** [the standard] in sanctification of the Spirit [the means] for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ [the purpose]

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

Living in light of eternity means we can rejoice in the midst of the present fiery trial because our love for God enables us to focus on the glories to come. 1 Peter 1:3–12 1 Peter 1:3, "**Blessed** be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

1 Peter 1:4, "to an **inheritance** incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,

1 Peter 1:5, "who are kept by the power of God through **faith** for **salvation** ready to be revealed in the last time."

#### **KEY DOCTRINES:**

Regeneration, Hope, the Resurrection of Jesus Christ; Inheritance; Personal sense of eternal destiny; Phases of salvation

1 Peter 1:6, "In this **you greatly rejoice**, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been **grieved** by various **trials**,

1 Peter 1:7, "that the genuineness of **your faith**, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is **tested by fire**, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

1 Peter 1:8, "whom having not seen you love (verb 4×; noun) Though now you do not see Him, yet **believing**, you **rejoice with joy inexpressible** and full of glory,

1 Peter 1:9, "receiving the end of your faith the salvation of your souls."

#### **KEY DOCTRINES:**

Problem solving; Adversity; Suffering; Faith as content of belief; Testing; Joy; Introduction to 10 spiritual skills; Unconditional love for God 1 Peter 1:10, "Of *this* salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace that would come to you,

1 Peter 1:11, "searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them **was indicating** when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the **glories** that would follow."

#### **KEY DOCTRINES:**

Messianic prophecy; First and Second Advents; Suffering Messiah; Royal Messiah 1 Peter 1:12, "To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things which angels desire to look into."

ἄφθαρτος *aphthartos* acc fem sing not liable to decay imperishable, immortal, incorruptible, imperishable, immortal, cannot spoil, be ruined, or be corrupted.

ἀμίαντος *amiantos* acc fem sing undefiled, unstained, spiritually defiled, or impure. 1 Pet. 1:3, "Blessed be the <u>God</u> and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, <u>who</u> according to His abundant mercy <u>has begotten us again</u> to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,"
