1 Thess. 5:1 Now as to the times [cro,noj, chronos] and the epochs [kairo,j, kairos], brethren, you have no need of anything to be written to you.

Age, aionos, a period of time in human history; an age; an age may include several dispensations.

Stewardship or administration, oivkonomi, a, oikonomia, which emphasizes the responsibility delegated by God to the human race during that period of time.

Dispensation: A distinct and identifiable administration in the development of God's plan and purposes for human history (Eph. 3:2; Col. 1:25–26).

a. A dispensation therefore is a distinct and identifiable administration in the development of God's plan and purposes for human history (Eph. 3:2; Col. 1:25–26).


b. A closely connected but not interchangeable word is age (Greek aion), which introduces the time element.

God manages the entirety of human history as a household, moving humanity through sequential stages of His administration, determined by the level of revelation He has provided up to that time in history.

d. Each administrative period is characterized by revelation that specifies responsibilities, a test in relation to those responsibilities, failure to pass the test, and God's gracious provision of a solution when failure occurs.
