Γίνομαι *ginomai*; verb, second person, singular, present, middle, imperative, “to come into being, to become”

γρηγορέω *grēgoreúō*; “to wake up, to awaken”

**Strengthen the things which were about to die**

**OR**

**Keep the things which are about to be thrown away.**

στήρισον Aor Act Imp 2s, στηρίζω *stēρίζō*;  
fut. *sterίχō*, from *hístemi*,  
“to stand. To set fast, to fix firmly”

τήρησον Aor Act Imper; 2s; τηρέω, *tereo*;  
“to keep the things which are about to be  
thrown away.”

present, n

γρηγορέω  
wake up,

εὕρισκω *heurískō*;  
Perf act Ind 1 s; Perfect, completed  
action, emphasizes the present  
results of a completed past action



Revelation 3:2, “Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for I have not found your works **perfect** before God.”

πληρόω *pleróō*; contracted *plēró̄*, fut. *plērósō*, from *plērēs* (4134), full. To make full, fill.  
perf pass ptcp periphrastic ptcp. Completes the thought of the main verb  
“I have not found”

**Revelation 3:3, “Remember therefore how you have received and heard; hold fast and repent. Therefore if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you.”**
