




$Ek =$ out from within



The Rapture is . . .


The resurrection of all dead Church Age believers and the translation of all living believers from the earth at the end of the Church Age before the Tribulation begins.

1 Thessalonians 4:13






Pre-Trib Rapture



The Rapture will occur before the Tribulation and will include all believers.



The Rapture occurs in the middle of the Tribulation, forcing believers to endure the first three and a half years of wrath.




The Rapture occurs at the end of the Tribulation, forcing all believers to endure the entire seven years.

Problems with Post-Trib



- (1) Believers subject to time of wrath**
- (2) An express elevator trip**
- (3) First the Antichrist**
- (4) Populating the Millennium**
- (5) Rapture = Second Coming**
- (6) No one to populate the Millennium**
