




WHAT is the Rapture?

1 Thessalonians 4:16



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

THE PRE-TRIB RAPTURE DOCTRINE

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Literal Interpretation

1. Definition

Imminency: the “at any moment” return of Jesus Christ.

OED: “hanging overhead, constantly ready to befall or overtake one; close at hand in its incidence.”

It is **certain** it will occur,
it is **uncertain** when it will occur;

It is **NOT** contingent on any other events;

and **NO** prophesied event intervenes between
the present time and the Rapture.

“EAGERLY WAIT”

Heb. 9:28, “so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who **eagerly wait** for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.”

“EAGERLY WAIT”

Pictures eager expectation indicated by the head bent forward to catch the first glance of an advancing procession.



The Tribulation is for Israel

JEWISH NATURE OF THE TRIBULATION

1. Time of preparation for Israel's restoration & conversion (Dt. 4:29,30; Jer. 30:3-11; Zech. 12:10).
2. Called "time of Jacob's tribulation" (Jer. 30:7)
3. Church currently experiences tribulations (Jn. 16:33), she will not experience "the" tribulation.
4. Church is mentioned 19 times in Rev. 1-3, but in ch. 4-19, that covers the tribulation period, the Church is never mentioned.

The judgments of the Tribulation are
unique in all of human history;
Matt. 24:21; Jer. 30:7; Dan. 12:1; Joel 2:2

Matt. 24:21, “for then there will be a great tribulation, such as has not occurred since the beginning of the world until now, nor ever shall.”

Daniel 12:1, “At that time Michael shall stand up, the great prince who stands *watch* over the sons of your people; and **there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation, even to that time.** And at that time your people shall be delivered, every one who is found written in the book.”

NATURE OF THE CHURCH

- 1. Purpose for the Church differs from Israel.**
- 2. Church is a “mystery” of Jews and Gentiles united in a co-equal body (Eph. 2:11–22; 3:1–13).**
- 3. Church is not appointed to wrath (i.e., the Tribulation] (Rom. 5:9; 1 Thes. 1:10; 5:9).**
- 4. Church is promised deliverance from the “hour” of testing (Rev. 3:10).**

The Church is NEVER the object of the wrath of God.

“**wrath**” is used first in Rev. 6,
the “wrath of the Lamb”

“**wrath**” is worldwide in scope

“**wrath**” involves supernatural
judgments and signs and
wonders on the earth.

“**wrath**” results in the deaths of
BILLIONS!

1 Th. 5:9, “For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,”

1 Th. 1:10, “and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, that is Jesus, who delivers us from the wrath to come.”

WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

The “Restrainer” in 2 Thess. 2:6, refers to the indwelling ministry of the Holy Spirit at work through the body of Christ during the current Church Age.

WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

“And you know what restrains (neuter) him now, so that in his time he may be revealed. For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains (masculine) will do so until He is taken out of the way.”

(2 Thessalonians 2:6, 7)

WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Since “the lawless one” (Antichrist) cannot be revealed until the Restrainer (Holy Spirit) is taken away (2 Thes. 2:7, 8), the Tribulation cannot begin until the church is removed.

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
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
