

Isa 11:15, "And the LORD will utterly destroy the tongue of the Sea of Egypt; And He will wave His hand over the River with His scorching wind; and He will strike it into seven streams and make men walk over dry-shod.

Isa 11:16, "And there will be a highway from Assyria for the remnant of His people who will be left, just as there was for Israel in the day that they came up out of the land of Egypt."

Ex. 9:22, "Now the LORD said to Moses, 'Stretch out your hand toward the sky, that hail may fall on all the land of Egypt, on man and on beast and on every plant of the field, throughout the land of Egypt.'

Ex. 9:23, "Moses stretched out his staff toward the sky, and the LORD sent thunder and hail, and fire ran down to the earth. And the LORD rained hail on the land of Egypt."

Joel 2:30, "And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth: blood and fire and pillars of smoke"

Psa. 105:32, "He gave them hail for rain, and flaming fire in their land.

Psa. 105:33, "He struck down their vines also and their fig trees, and shattered the trees of their territory."

Joel 1:15, "Alas for the day! For the day of the LORD is at hand; It shall come as destruction from the Almighty.

Joel 1:16, "Is not the food cut off before our eyes, joy and gladness from the house of our God?

Joel 1:17, "The seed shrivels under the clods, storehouses are in shambles; barns are broken down, for the grain has withered.

Rev. 8:10, "The third angel sounded, and a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of waters.

Rev. 8:11, "The name of the star is called Wormwood; and a third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the waters, because they were made bitter."





## **The Fourth Trumpet**

Rev. 8:12, "The fourth angel sounded, and a third of the sun and a third of the moon and a third of the stars were struck, so that a third of them would be darkened and the day would not shine for a third of it, and the night in the same way."
