
John 15:18, "If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before *it hated* you.






Medio-Persian Empire

Psa. 72:9, "Let the nomads of the desert bow before him, and his enemies lick the dust.

Psa. 72:10, "Let the kings of Tarshish and of the islands bring presents; the kings of Sheba and Seba offer gifts.

Psa. 72:11, "And let all kings bow down before him, all nations serve him."

Psa. 2:1, "Why are the nations in an uproar and the peoples devising a vain thing?

Psa. 2:2, "The kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers take counsel together against the LORD and against His Anointed, saying,

Psa. 2:3, "'Let us tear their fetters apart and cast away their cords from us!'

Psa. 2:4, "He who sits in the heavens laughs, the Lord scoffs at them.

Psa. 2:5, "Then He will speak to them in His anger and terrify them in His fury, saying,"

Psa. 2:7, "I will surely tell of the decree of the LORD: He said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.


Psa. 2:8, "Ask of Me, and I will surely give the nations as Your inheritance, and the very ends of the earth as Your possession.

Psa. 2:9, "You shall break them with a rod of iron, You shall shatter them like earthenware."

His kingdom is without end (Ex. 15:18; Ps. 10:16; 145:13; Isa. 9:7; Dan. 2:44; 4:3; 6:26; 7:14, 18, 27; Mic. 4:7; Luke 1:33; 1 Tim. 1:17; 2 Pet. 1:11; Rev. 11:15).

Rev. 11:16, "And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God,"



1. They are "elders," *presbuteroi*, a word never used of angels.

2. There is an absence of the mention of these 24 elders in heaven prior to the events of Rev 4.

3. The prophecies in *Daniel* are the frame of reference for the book of Revelation. In Dan 7:9...

"I watched till thrones [pl.] were put in place, and the Ancient of Days was seated; His garment was white as snow, and the hair of His head was like pure wool. His throne [sg.] was a fiery flame, its wheels a burning fire;"

4. The number, 24, is based on the representative priesthood in Israel. 1 Chron 24:3, 4; 1 Chron 15:9–30

5. The white garments are those of rewarded Church age believers.

Rev 3:5, 18

6. The golden crown are stephanos, rewarded crowns, not diademos crowns of royalty. Angels are never said to wear victor crowns, only humans.

7. The function of the 24 elders, as kings and priests, fits the role of the glorified church, not the role of angels.

Revelation 5:10, "And have made <u>you</u> kings and priests to our God; and you shall reign on the earth."

8. These 24 elders are redeemed by the blood of the Lamb (Rev 5:9), angels are not redeemed.

Rev. 11:17, "saying, 'We give You thanks, O Lord God, the <u>Almighty</u>, who are and who were, because You have taken Your great <u>power</u> and have begun to reign."

Rev. 1:8, "I am the Alpha and the Omega,' says the Lord God, 'who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."

Rev. 4:8, "And the four living creatures, each one of them having six wings, are full of eyes around and within; and day and night they do not cease to say, 'HOLY, HOLY, HOLY is THE LORD GOD, THE ALMIGHTY, WHO WAS AND WHO IS AND WHO IS TO COME."

Rev. 11:17, "saying, 'We give You thanks, O Lord God, the Almighty, who are and who were, because You have taken Your great power and have begun to reign."

Rev. 15:3, "And they sang the song of Moses, the bond-servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, 'Great and marvelous are Your works, O Lord God, the Almighty; Righteous and true are Your ways, King of the nations!"

Rev. 16:7, "And I heard the altar saying, 'Yes, O Lord God, the Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments."

Rev. 16:14, "for they are spirits of demons, performing signs, which go out to the kings of the whole world, to gather them together for the war of the great day of God, the Almighty."

Rev. 19:6, "Then I heard something like the voice of a great multitude and like the sound of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, saying, 'Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, the Almighty, reigns.'

Rev. 19:7, "Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready." Rev. 19:15, "From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty."

Rev. 21:22, "I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb are its temple."

Rev. 11:18, "And the nations were enraged, and Your wrath came, and the time came for the dead to be judged, and the time to reward Your bond-servants the prophets and the saints and those who fear Your name, the small and the great, and to destroy those who destroy the earth."
