Ezek. 37:25, “Then they shall dwell in the land that I have given to Jacob My servant, where your fathers dwelt; and they shall dwell there, they, their children, and their children’s children, forever; and My servant David shall be their prince forever.

Ezek. 37:26, “Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them, and it shall be an everlasting covenant with them; I will establish them and multiply them, and I will set My sanctuary in their midst forevermore.

Ezek. 37:27, “My tabernacle also shall be with them; indeed I will be their God, and they shall be My people.”

Jer. 31:33, “But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

Ezek. 36:25, “Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols.



Ezek. 36:26, “I will give you a new heart and put a **new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.**




The Division of Land During the Millennium




Land granted to Abraham

0 50 100 kilometers




**THE DIVISION OF THE LAND
DURING THE MILLENNIUM**








THE GATE TO THE MILLENNIAL TEMPLE








THE MILLENNIAL ALTAR



Lev. 4:20, “He shall also do with the bull just as he did with the bull of the sin offering; thus he shall do with it. So the priest shall make atonement for them, and they shall be forgiven.”

Lev. 4:26, “And all its fat he shall offer up in smoke on the altar as in the case of the fat of the sacrifice of peace offerings. Thus the priest shall make atonement for him in regard to his sin, and he shall be forgiven.”

Lev. 4:31, “Then he shall remove all its fat, just as the fat was removed from the sacrifice of peace offerings; and the priest shall offer it up in smoke on the altar for a soothing aroma to the LORD. Thus the priest shall make atonement for him, and he shall be forgiven.”

Lev. 4:35, “Then he shall remove all its fat, just as the fat of the lamb is removed from the sacrifice of the peace offerings, and the priest shall offer them up in smoke on the altar, on the offerings by fire to the LORD. Thus the priest shall make atonement for him in regard to his sin which he has committed, and he shall be forgiven.”

Heb. 10:4, “For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.”

Ezek. 40:46, “but the chamber which faces toward the north is for the priests who keep charge of the altar. These are the **sons of Zadok, who from the sons of Levi come near to the LORD to minister to Him.”**

“Jesus Christ is the only Mediator, His blood the final sacrifice. There can be no going back. If there is a way back to the ceremonial law, to the types and shadows of what has now become the bondage of legalism, then Paul labored and ran in vain—more than that, Christ died in vain.”

Isa. 56:7, “Even those I will bring to My holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their **burnt offerings and their sacrifices** will be acceptable on My altar; for My house will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples.”

Isa. 66:20, “ ‘Then they shall bring all your brethren from all the nations as a **grain offering to the LORD, on horses, in chariots, in litters, on mules, and on camels, to My holy mountain Jerusalem,’ says the LORD, ‘just as the sons of Israel bring their **grain offering** in a clean vessel to the house of the LORD.**”

Isa. 66:21, “ ‘I will also take some of them for priests and for Levites,’ says the LORD.”

Isa. 66:22, “ ‘For just as the new heavens and the new earth which I make will endure before Me,’ declares the LORD, ‘so your offspring and your name will endure.

Isa. 66:23, “ ‘And it shall be from new moon to new moon and from sabbath to sabbath, all mankind will come to bow down before Me,’ says the LORD.”

Jer. 33:18, “and the Levitical priests shall never lack a man before Me to offer burnt offerings, to burn grain offerings, and to prepare sacrifices continually.”

Zech. 14:16, “Then it will come about that any who are left of all the nations that went against Jerusalem will go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to celebrate the **Feast of Booths.”**

Zech. 14:17, “And it will be that whichever of the families of the earth does not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, there will be no rain on them.”

Zech. 14:18, “And if the family of Egypt does not go up or enter, then no rain will fall on them; it will be the plague with which the LORD smites the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths.

Zech. 14:19, “This will be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths.”

Zech. 14:20, “In that day there will be inscribed on the bells of the horses, ‘HOLY TO THE LORD.’ And the cooking pots in the LORD’s house will be like the bowls before the altar.

Zech. 14:21, “And every cooking pot in Jerusalem and in Judah will be holy to the LORD of hosts; and all who sacrifice will come and take of them and boil in them. And there will no longer be a Canaanite in the house of the LORD of hosts in that day.”

Mal. 3:3, “And He will sit as a smelter and purifier of silver, and He will purify the sons of Levi and refine them like gold and silver, so that they may present to the LORD offerings in righteousness.

Mal. 3:4, “Then the offering of Judah and Jerusalem will be pleasing to the LORD, as in the days of old and as in former years.”
