

1. **Argument from the character of God**

The believer is secured by the purpose, power, provision, and love of God the Father.

Rom. 8:29, “For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the first-born among many brethren;

Rom. 8:30, “and whom He predestined, these He also called; and whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.”

James 2:10, “whoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all.”

Jude 1:24, “Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy,”

Romans 8:33, “Who shall bring a charge against God’s elect? *It is* God who justifies.”
