The Sherlock Holmes Principle of Hermeneutics

Principle: When we have eliminated the impossible, whatever is left, no matter how improbable, is the answer.

Brethren never combines the two:


i.e., Gentile believers + Jewish unbelievers

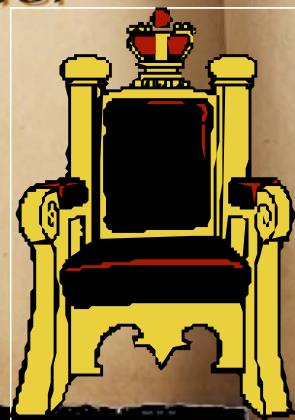


“For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.”

10, "According to the grace of God which was given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building on it. But each man must be careful how he builds on it.

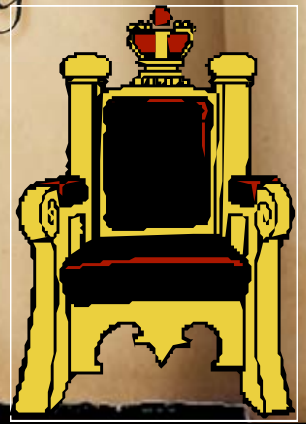
11, "For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

12, "Now if any man builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw,

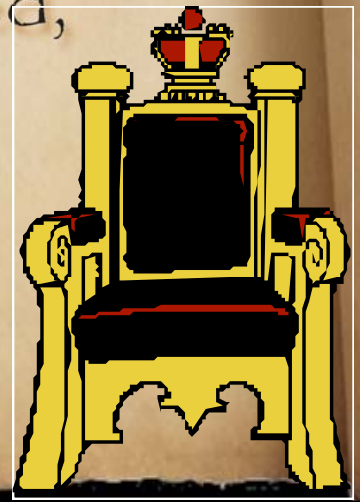
13, "each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is to be revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work.
