Paraphrase:

You have a choice every day; God gives you these options: life and divine good; death (self destruction, self-induced misery) and human good and sin.

The key to option A or B is learning the Bible so you can love God. Love for God is evidenced by thinking like God, living as God would have you live. By keeping His Word (not the 10 commandments) we show we love Him and God will bless us.
