(Jeremiah 47:1)

Jeremiah 22:26, “I will hurl you and your mother who bore you into another country where you were not born, and there you will die.

Jeremiah 22:27, “But as for the land to which they desire to return, they will not return to it.

Jeremiah 22:28, “Is this man Coniah a despised, shattered jar? Or is he an undesirable vessel? Why have he and his descendants been hurled out and cast into a land that they had not known?”

Jeremiah 22:29, “O land, land, land, Hear the word of the Lord!

Jeremiah 22:30, “Thus says the Lord, ‘Write this man down childless, a man who will not prosper in his days; for no man of his descendants will prosper sitting on the throne of David or ruling again in Judah.’ ”

**The point of Matthew's genealogy is to show why
a physical son of Joseph could not be King.**

Ex. 20:1, “And God spoke all these words, saying:

Ex. 20:2. “I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

Ex. 20:3, “You shall have no other gods before Me.

Ex. 20:4, “You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth;”

Ex. 20:5, “you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me,

Ex. 20:6, “but showing mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.”

Jer. 17:5, “Thus says the LORD: ‘Cursed is the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his strength, whose heart departs from the LORD.

Jer. 17:6, “ ‘For he shall be like a shrub in the desert, and shall not see when good comes, but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, in a salt land which is not inhabited.’ ”

Jer. 17:7, “Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD, and whose hope is the LORD.

Jer. 17:8, “For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, which spreads out its roots by the river, and will not fear when heat comes; but its leaf will be green, and will not be anxious in the year of drought, nor will cease from yielding fruit.

Jer. 17:9, “The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; who can know it?”
