Acts 1:6, “Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, ‘Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?’ ”

Acts 15:16, “ ‘After this I will return and will rebuild the tabernacle of David, which has fallen down; I will rebuild its ruins, and I will set it up;

Acts 15:17, “ ‘So that the rest of mankind may seek the LORD, even all the Gentiles who are called by My name, says the LORD who does all these things.’ ”

Amos 9:11, “On that day I will raise up the tabernacle of David, which has fallen down, and repair its damages; I will raise up its ruins, and rebuild it as in the days of old;”

Rom. 8:19, “For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God.

Deut. 18:17, “And the LORD said to me: ‘What they have spoken is good.

Deut. 18:18, “ ‘I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their brethren, and will put My words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him.

Deut. 18:19, “ ‘And it shall be that whoever will not hear My words, which He speaks in My name, I will require it of him.’ ”

Num. 12:6, “Then He said, ‘Hear now My words: If there is a prophet among you, I, the LORD, make Myself known to him in a vision; I speak to him in a dream.

Num. 12:7, “ ‘Not so with My servant Moses; He is faithful in all My house.

Num. 12:8, “ ‘I speak with him face to face, even plainly, and not in dark sayings; and he sees the form of the LORD. Why then were you not afraid to speak against My servant Moses?’ ”

Acts 3:26, “To you first, God, having raised up His Servant Jesus, sent Him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from your iniquities.”
