Promises of a Divine Messiah Romans 9:4–5



A Human and Divine Messiah

Isaiah 7:14, "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and <u>bear a son</u>, and she will call His name <u>Immanuel</u>." A Human and Divine Messiah almah: a young, unmarried woman, usually understood to be a virgin.

betulah: a virgin of any age, but in Joel 1:8 refers to a young widow, obviously not a virgin.

na'ardh: a young woman who may (1 Kings 1:2) or may not (Ruth 2:6) be a virgin.
