

1. Why do people go to the Lake of Fire?

Not for sin, but for unbelief in Christ.

John 3:18, “He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.”

John 3:36, “He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.”

John 5:24, “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.”

1 Cor. 15:22, “For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.”

Rom. 5:12, “Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned—”

Rom. 5:15, “But the free gift is not like the offense. For if by the one man’s offense many died, much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many.

Rom. 5:16, “And the gift is not like that which came through the one who sinned. For the judgment which came from one offense resulted in condemnation, but the free gift which came from many offenses resulted in justification.”

Rom. 3:10, “as it is written, ‘THERE IS NONE RIGHTEOUS, NOT EVEN ONE; [Psa. 14:1–3]”

Isa. 64:6, “All our works of righteousness are filthy rags.”

Col. 2:13, “And you, being dead [when you were dead] in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, [because He] having forgiven you all trespasses,

Col. 2:14, “[when He] having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, [because He] having nailed it to the cross.”

2 Cor. 5:19, “that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.”

Rev. 22:12, “And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work.”

Matt. 5:16, “Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.”

John 3:19, “And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.”

John 6:28, “Then they said to Him, ‘What shall we do, that we may work the works of God?’

John 6:29, “Jesus answered and said to them, ‘This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent.’ ”

Rom. 3:20, “Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin.”

Gal. 5:19, “Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness,”

Eph. 2:8, “For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God

Eph. 2:9, “not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Eph. 2:10, “For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.”

Rom. 2:6, “who will render to each one according to his deeds”:

2 Cor. 11:15, “Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also transform themselves into ministers of righteousness, whose end will be according to their works.”

2 Tim. 4:14, “Alexander the coppersmith did me much harm. May the Lord repay him according to his works.”

1 Pet. 1:17, “And if you call on the Father, who without partiality judges according to each one’s work, conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay here in fear;”
