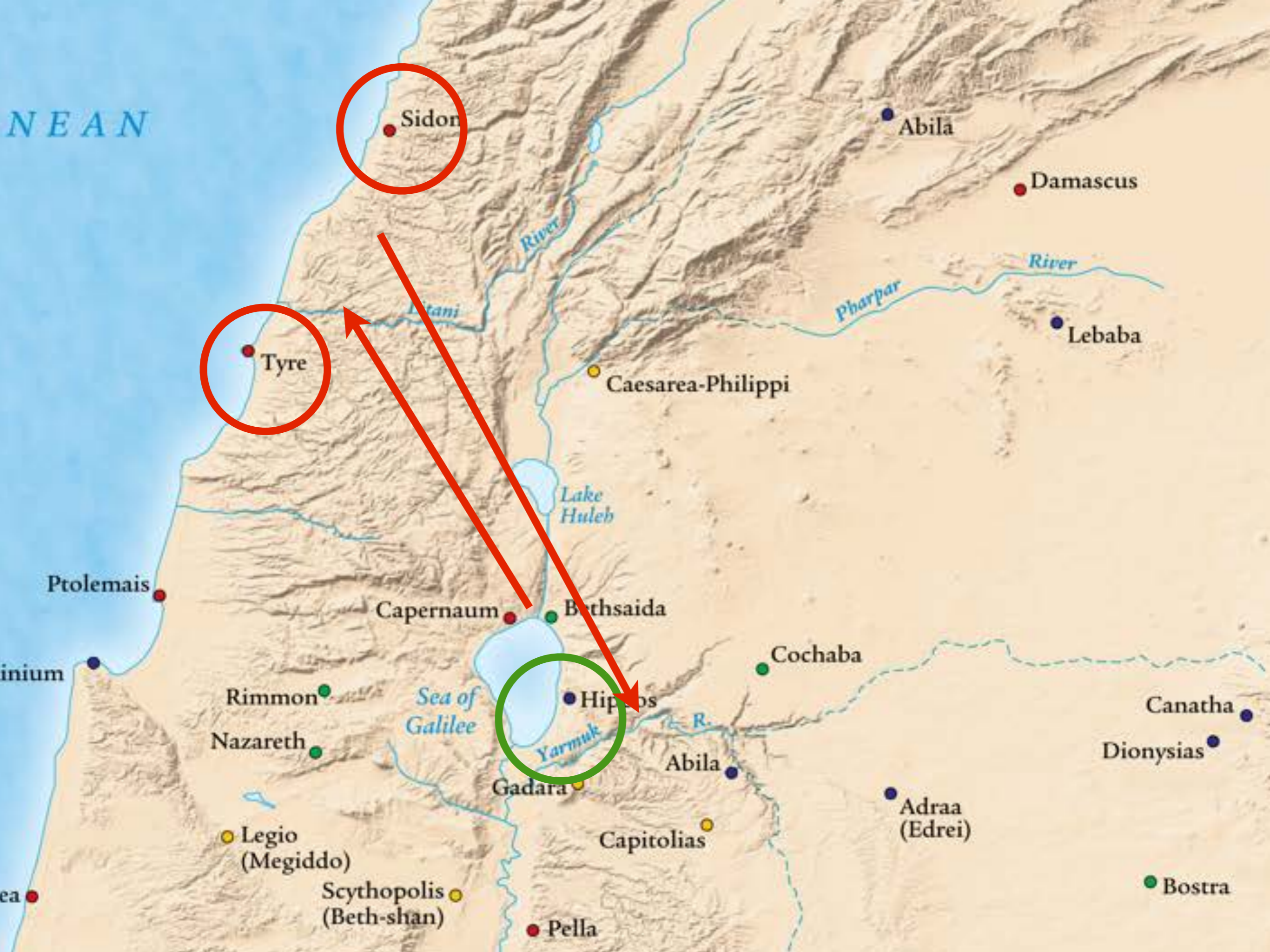

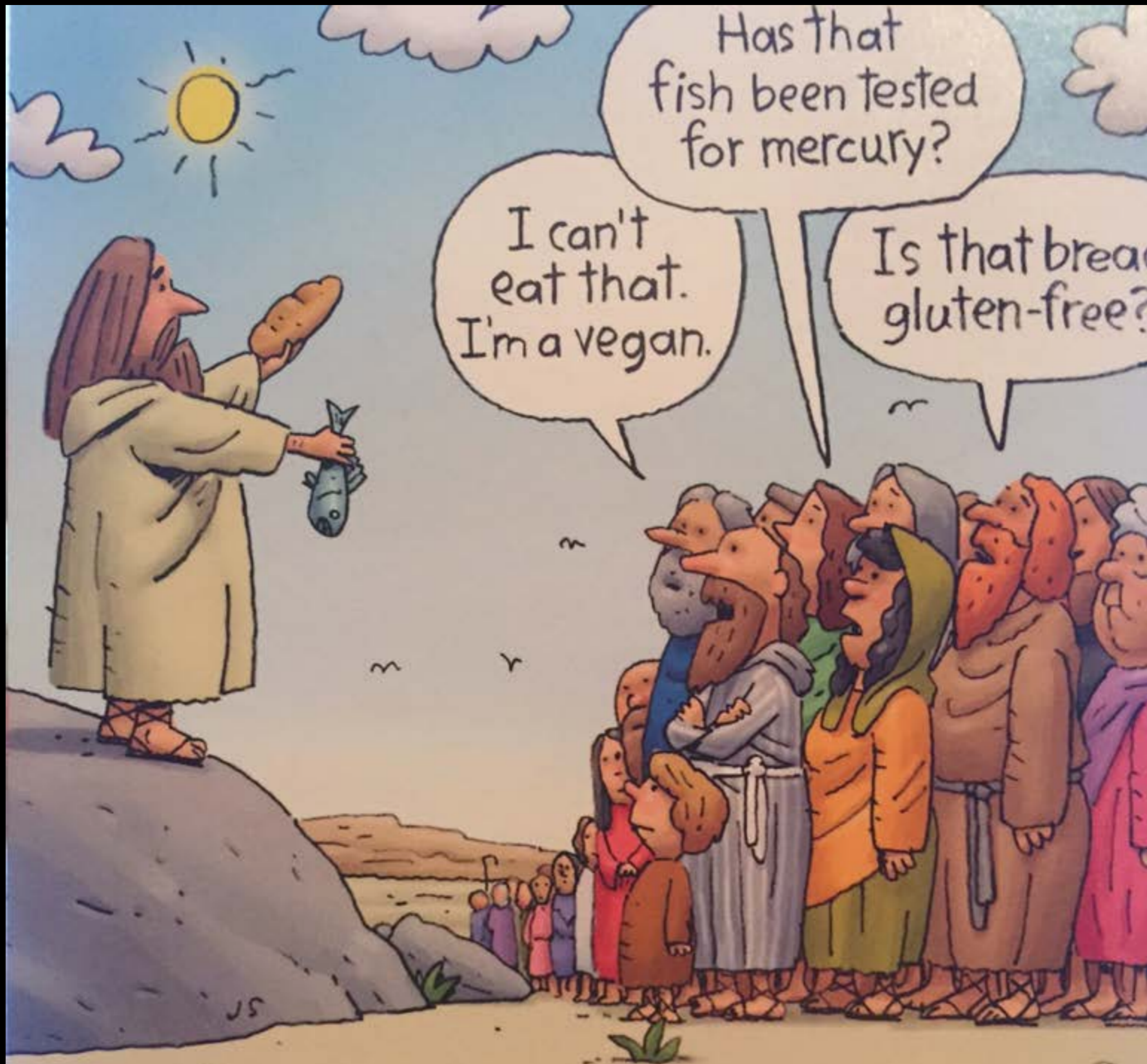

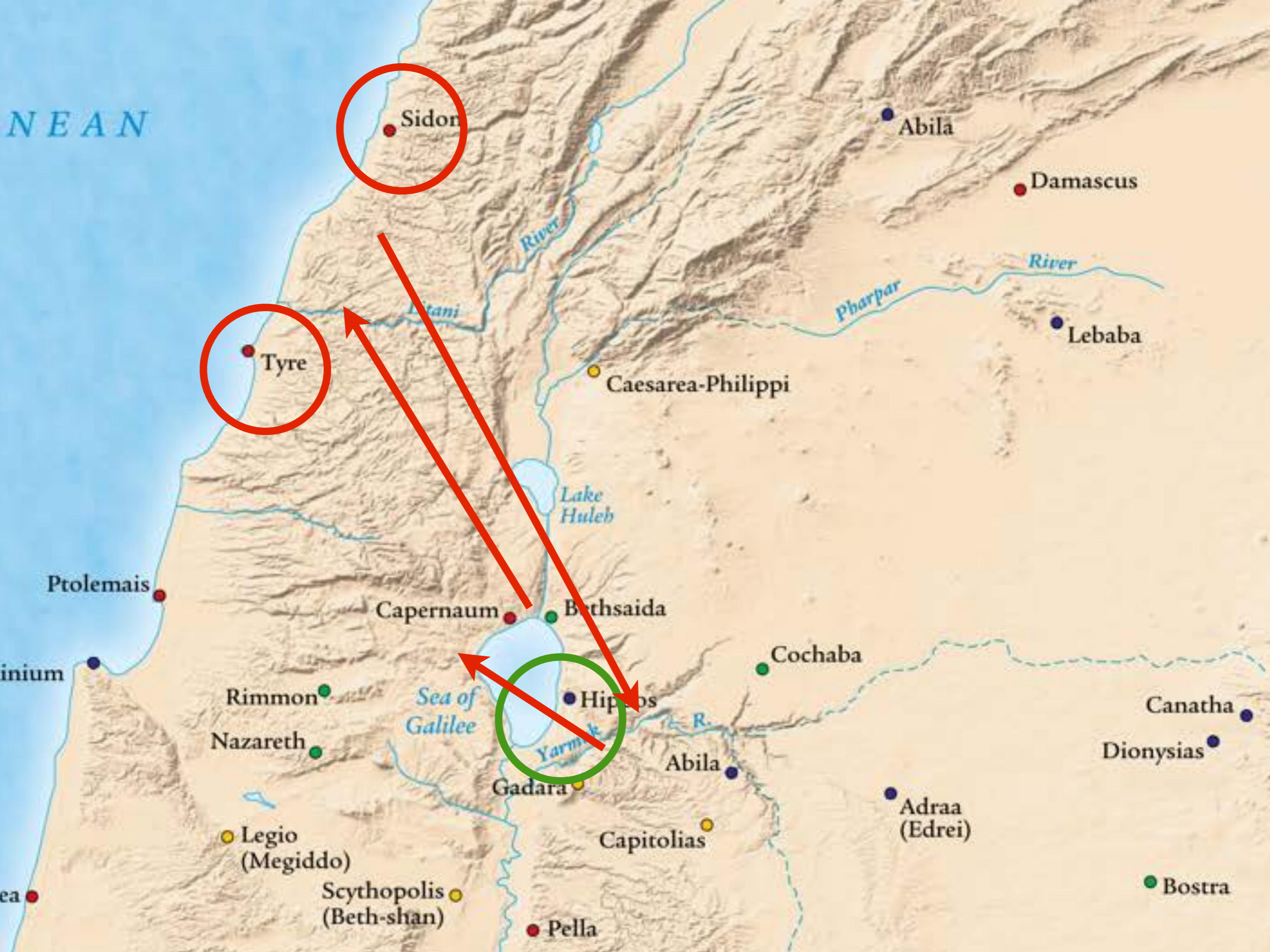
Matt. 15:37, “So they all ate and were filled, and they took up seven large baskets full of the fragments that were left.”

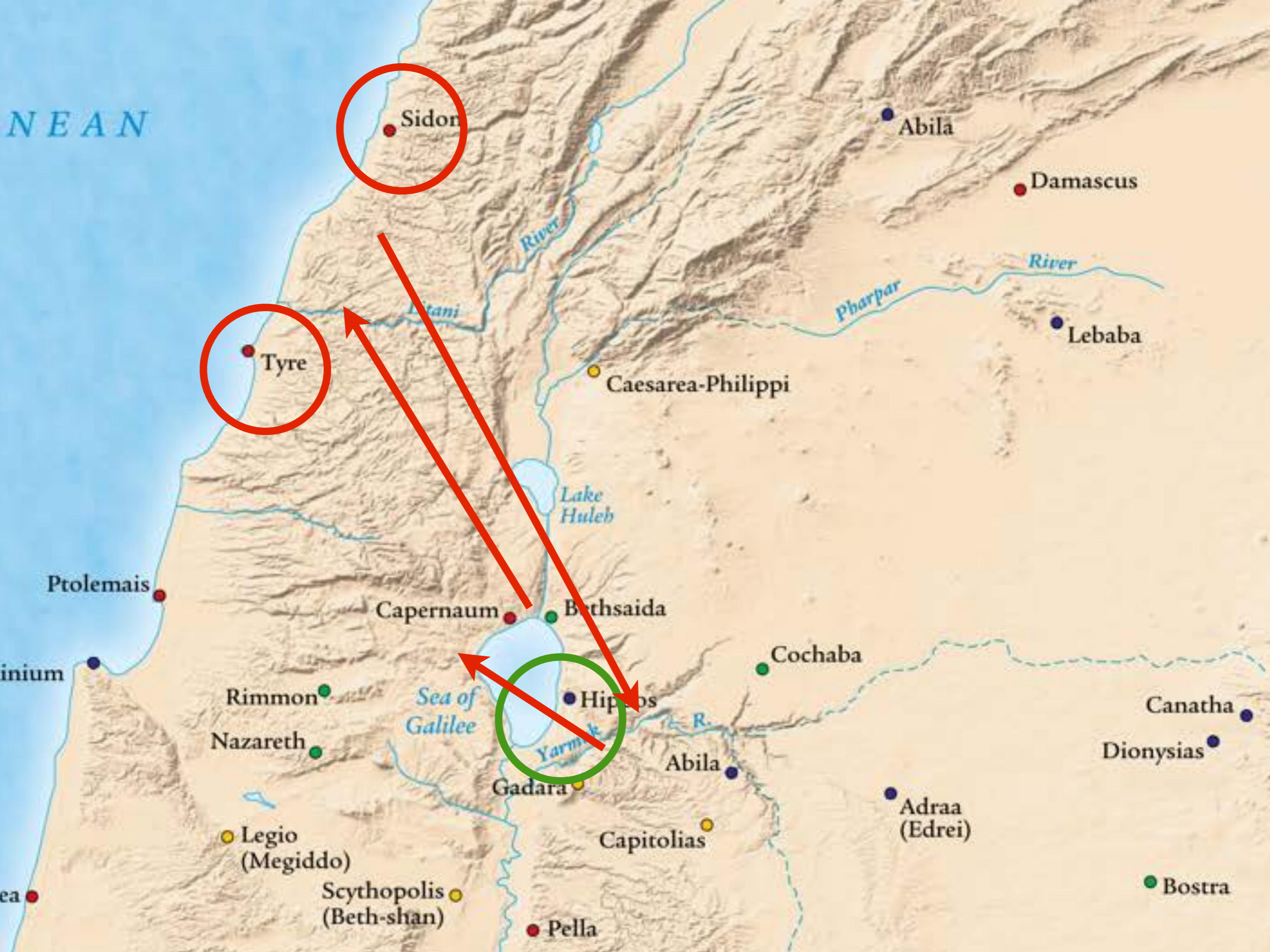
The Bible PLUS

Adding to the Bible: Other revelation; psychology; sociology; philosophy; other religious books; mystical claims

The Bible MINUS (rationalism, religious liberalism, skepticism)

Subtracting from the Bible: Rejecting inerrancy, infallibility, sufficiency.
