

Gen. 1:3–2:3 Seven Days of Restoration Isa. 14:12, "How you have <u>fallen from heaven</u>, O star of the morning, son of the dawn [*Helel ben shahar*]! You have been cut down to the earth, You who have weakened the nations!

Isa. 14:13, "But you said in your heart, '<u>I will</u> ascend to heaven; <u>I will</u> raise my throne above the stars of God, and <u>I will</u> sit on the mount of assembly in the recesses of the north.

Isa. 14:14, " '<u>I will</u> ascend above the heights of the clouds; <u>I will</u> make myself like the Most High.'

Isa. 14:15, "Nevertheless you will be thrust down to Sheol, to the <u>recesses of the pit</u>."

Ezek. 28:12, "Son of man, take up a lamentation over the king of Tyre, and say to him, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "You had the seal of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty.

Ezek. 28:13, "'<u>You were in Eden</u>, the garden of God; Every precious stone was your covering: The ruby, the topaz, and the diamond; The beryl, the onyx, and the jasper; The lapis lazuli, the turquoise, and the emerald; And the gold, the workmanship of your settings and sockets, was in you. On the day that you were created they were prepared."'" Ezek. 28:14, "'"You were the anointed cherub who covers, and I placed you there. You were on the holy mountain of God; You walked in the midst of the stones of fire.


Ezek. 28:15, "'"You were blameless in your ways from the day you were created, until unrighteousness was found in you.

Ezek. 28:16, "'"By the abundance of your trade You were internally filled with violence, and you sinned; Therefore I have cast you as profane from the mountain of God. And I have destroyed you, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire."'" Ezek. 28:17, "'"Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty; You corrupted your wisdom by reason of your splendor. I cast you to the ground; I put you before kings, that they may see you.

Ezek. 28:18, "'"By the multitude of your iniquities, in the unrighteousness of your trade, you profaned your sanctuaries. Therefore I have brought fire from the midst of you; It has consumed you, and I have turned you to ashes on the earth in the eyes of all who see you.

Ezek. 28:19, " ' "All who know you among the peoples are appalled at you; You have become terrified, and you will be no more." ' " Matt. 25:41, "Then He will also say to those on His left, 'Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil and his angels;"

ESSENCE OF GOD



God vindicates or exonerates His character through human history. Each dispensation puts His love, righteousness, justice on display for all to see.

- He extends a grace-salvation to undeserving sinners.
- His righteousness and justice are satisfied through a perfect salvation.
- And the extent of eternal punishment is shown to be just because of the horrific consequences of sin.

THE CREATION (EDENIC) COVENANT

Gen. 1:28, "And God blessed them; and God said to them, 'Be <u>fruitful</u> and <u>multiply</u>, and <u>fill</u> the earth, and <u>subdue</u> it; and <u>rule</u> over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.'

Gen. 1:29, "Then God said, 'Behold, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the surface of all the earth, and every tree which has fruit yielding seed; it shall be food for you;

Gen. 1:30, "'and to every beast of the earth and to every bird of the sky and to every thing that moves on the earth which has life, I have given every green plant for food'; and it was so." Gen. 2:15, "Then the LORD God took the man and put him into the garden of Eden to <u>cultivate</u> it and <u>keep</u> it.

Gen. 2:16, "And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, 'From any tree of the garden you may eat freely;

Gen. 2:17, " 'but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil <u>you shall not</u> <u>eat</u>, for in the day that you eat from it you shall surely die.' " Hos. 6:7, "But like men [*keAdam*] they [?] transgressed the [no article in Hebrew] covenant;"

Hos. 6:7, "But like Adam they have transgressed the covenant;"

THE ADAMIC COVENANT

Gen. 3:14, "So the LORD God said to the serpent: 'Because you have done this, you are cursed more than all cattle, and more than every beast of the field; on your belly you shall go, and you shall eat dust all the days of your life.

Gen. 3:15, " 'And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.'

Gen. 3:16, "To the woman He said: 'I will greatly multiply your sorrow and your conception; in pain you shall bring forth children; your desire shall be for your husband, and he shall rule over you.' " Gen. 3:17, "Then to Adam He said, 'Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, "You shall not eat of it": Cursed is the ground for your sake; in toil you shall eat of it all the days of your life.

Gen. 3:18, " 'Both thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you, and you shall eat the herb of the field.

Gen. 3:19, " 'In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread till you return to the ground, for out of it you were taken; for dust you are, and to dust you shall return.' "
