1 CHRONICLES 15:1–16; ISAIAH 6:1–4

**John 1:14, “And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.”**

**John 2:11, “This beginning of signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory; and His disciples believed in Him.”**



**John 12:35, “Then Jesus said to them, ‘A little while longer the light is with you. Walk while you have the light, lest darkness overtake you; he who walks in darkness does not know where he is going.**

**John 12:36, “ ‘While you have the light, believe in the light, that you may become sons of light.’ These things Jesus spoke, and departed, and was hidden from them.”**

**Isa. 6:6, “Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal which he had taken with the tongs from the altar.”**









**Gen. 3:8, “And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden.**

**Gen. 3:9, “Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, ‘Where are you?’**

**Gen. 3:10, “So he said, ‘I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself.’ ”**



**Job 40:3, “Then Job answered the LORD and said:**

**Job 40:4, “ ‘Behold, I am vile; What shall I answer You? I lay my hand over my mouth.**

**Job 40:5, “ ‘Once I have spoken, but I will not answer; Yes, twice, but I will proceed no further.’ ”**



**Job 42:1, “Then Job answered the LORD and said:**

**Job 42:2, “ ‘I know that You can do everything, and that no purpose of Yours can be withheld from You.’ ”**



**Job 42:3, “ ‘You asked, “Who is this who hides counsel without knowledge?” Therefore I have uttered what I did not understand, things too wonderful for me, which I did not know.**

**Job 42:4, “ ‘Listen, please, and let me speak; You said, “I will question you, and you shall answer Me.”**

**Job 42:5, “ ‘I have heard of You by the hearing of the ear, but now my eye sees You.**

**Job 42:6, “ ‘Therefore I abhor myself, and repent in dust and ashes.’ ”**



**Gen. 28:16, “Then Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, ‘Surely the LORD is in this place, and I did not know it.’**

**Gen. 28:17, “And he was afraid and said, ‘How awesome is this place! This is none other than the house of God, and this is the gate of heaven!’ ”**



**Ex. 19:16, “Then it came to pass on the third day, in the morning, that there were thunderings and lightnings, and a thick cloud on the mountain; and the sound of the trumpet was very loud, so that all the people who were in the camp trembled.”**



**Ex. 20:18**, “Now all the people witnessed the thunderings, the lightning flashes, the sound of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking; and when the people saw it, they trembled and stood afar off.

**Ex. 20:19**, “Then they said to Moses, ‘You speak with us, and we will hear; but let not God speak with us, lest we die.’

**Ex. 20:20**, “And Moses said to the people, ‘Do not fear; for God has come to test you, and that His fear may be before you, so that you may not sin.’

**Ex. 20:21**, “So the people stood afar off, but Moses drew near the thick darkness where God was.”



**Ex. 24:1, “Now He said to Moses, ‘Come up to the LORD, you and Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, and worship from afar.’ ”**

**Ex. 24:9, “Then Moses went up, also Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel,**

**Ex. 24:10, “and they saw the God of Israel. And there was under His feet as it were a paved work of sapphire stone, and it was like the very heavens in its clarity.**

**Ex. 24:11, “But on the nobles of the children of Israel He did not lay His hand. So they saw God, and they ate and drank.”**



**Ex. 33:10, “All the people saw the pillar of cloud standing at the tabernacle door, and all the people rose and worshiped, each man in his tent door.”**
