1 Pet. 1:16, "because it is written, 'Be holy, for I am holy.'"

Ex. 19:5, "'Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine.

Ex. 19:6, "'And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.'
These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel."

Lev. 21:8, "Therefore you shall consecrate him, for he offers the bread of your God. He shall be holy to you, for I the LORD, who sanctify you, am holy."

John 13:10, "Jesus said to him [Peter], 'He who is bathed [completely washed (positional cleansing)] needs only to wash his feet [confession, experiential cleansing], but is completely clean; and you all (the 11) are clean [positionally], but not all of you [all but Judas].'"

Psa. 32:5, "I acknowledged my sin to You, and my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, 'I will confess my transgressions to the LORD,' and You forgave the iniquity of my sin. Selah"

Eph. 5:18, "And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit,

Eph. 5:19, "speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,

Eph. 5:20, "giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,"

2. Spring Feasts

Passover (payment for sin, redemption)

Unleavened Bread (the spiritual life)

First Fruits (resurrection, new life)

Psa. 42:4, "When I remember these things, I pour out my soul within me. For I used to go with the multitude; I went with them to the house of God, with the voice of joy and praise, with a multitude that kept a pilgrim feast."

Psa. 100:4, "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name."

Psa. 122:0, "A Song of Ascents. Of David.

Psa. 122:1, "I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go into the house of the LORD.' "

1 Cor. 5:7, "Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.

1 Cor. 5:8, "Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth."
