What the Bible Teaches About The Davidic Covenant

Psalm 89

- 1A. God's love and faithfulness are praised, Psa. 89:1–18.
- 2A. God's promise to David is the foundation of the psalmist's petition, Psa. 89:19–37.
- 3A. God is petitioned to remain faithful to His promises to David even though sin and divine discipline made it appear that the covenant was cancelled, Psa. 89:38–52.

Psalm 89

- 1A. God's love and faithfulness are praised, Psa. 89:1–18.
 - 1B Psa. 89:1–4 God's covenant loyalty and faithfulness are praised.
 - 2B Psa. 89:5–18 God's unique and awesome character, especially His righteousness, faithfulness, justice, and power are extolled.
 - 1C The Lord will be praised, Psa. 89:5.
 - 2C The Lord will be praised for His unique and awesome attributes, Psa. 89:6–8.
 - 3C The Lord is praised for His omnipotence and His sovereign rule over creation, Psa. 89:9–14.
 - 4C The Lord blesses those who walk with Him and glory in His righteousness and strength, Psa. 89:15–18.

The Faith-Rest Drill

STEP ONE: Claim a promise; mix faith with a promise, principle, or rationale.

STEP TWO: Think through the doctrinal rationales embedded in the promise.

STEP THREE: Appropriate the doctrinal conclusions.

<u>Psa. 89:5,</u> "And the heavens will praise Your wonders, O LORD; Your faithfulness also in the assembly of the saints [holy ones, i.e., angels]."

קרוש qadosh masc plur abs holy, set apart, unique, distinct, one of kind. In this sense, those who are set apart to the service of God.

Psa. 89:6, "For who in the heavens can be compared to the LORD?

Who among the sons of the mighty can be likened to the LORD?

Psa. 89:7, "God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints ["holy ones"], And to be held in reverence by all those around Him."

Psa. 89:9, "You rule the raging of the sea; When its waves rise, You still them."

אוּת ge'uth comm fem sing constr "to rise up, can mean either majesty or pride, arrogance"

Psa. 46:3, "Though its waters roar and be troubled,

Though the mountains shake with its swelling." [pride]

Psa. 89:10, "You have broken <u>Rahab</u> in pieces, as one who is slain; You have scattered Your enemies with Your mighty arm."

ַרַהַב comm masc sing abs *Rahab, Rahav* קר proper *Rahab*, literally, *Ra<u>c</u>hav*, name This term shows up in in Job 9:13; Job 26:12; Psalm 40:4; 87:4; 89:10; Isaiah 51:9; Isaiah 30:7. TWOT describes the verbal form in this manner:

The basic meaning of the noun is arrogance. *Rahav*, can best be translated as "the arrogant one."

founded them."

Psa. 89:13, "You have a mighty arm; Strong is Your hand, and high is Your right hand."

Psa. 17:7, "Show Your marvelous lovingkindness by Your <u>right hand</u>, O You who save those who trust in You From those who rise up against them."

Psa. 18:35, "You have also given me the shield of Your salvation; Your right hand has held me up," Ex. 6:6, "Therefore say to the children of Israel: 'I am the LORD; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.' " Deut. 5:15, "And remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the LORD your God brought you out from there by a <u>mighty hand</u> and by an <u>outstretched arm;</u> therefore the LORD your God commanded you to keep the Sabbath day."

Jer. 21:5, "I Myself will fight against you with an <u>outstretched hand and with a</u> <u>strong arm</u>, even in anger and fury and great wrath."

Jer. 27:5, "I have made the earth, the man and the beast that are on the ground, by <u>My great power and by My outstretched</u> <u>arm</u>, and have given it to whom it seemed proper to Me." Psa. 89:14, "Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; Mercy and truth go before Your face."

אָדֶר*ק tzedek* comm masc sing abs "righteousness," the standard of God's character.

ບອຸຫຼ່າວ *mishpat* comm masc sing abs "judgment," the application of God's righteousness. Psa. 37:6, "He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, And your justice as the noonday."

Psa. 48:10, "According to Your name, O God, So is Your praise to the ends of the earth; Your right hand is full of righteousness." Psa. 96:13, "For He is coming, for He is coming to judge the earth. He shall judge the world with righteousness, And the peoples with His truth."

Psa. 89:16, "In Your name they rejoice all day long, And in Your righteousness they are exalted."

Psa. 89:17, "For You are the glory of their strength, And in Your favor our horn is exalted."

Psa. 89:18, "For our shield belongs to the LORD, And our king to the Holy One of Israel."

Psa. 18:2, "The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer;

My God, my strength, in whom I will trust;

My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold."

Psa. 28:7, "The LORD is my strength and my shield;

My heart trusted in Him, and I am helped;

Therefore my heart greatly rejoices, And with my song I will praise Him."

Psa. 119:114, "You are my hiding place and my shield; I hope in Your word."
