  - B. Proclaiming a veiled gospel, vv. 3–5
    - Jesus, Satan is "The prince of this world."
    - Paul, Satan is "The prince of the power of the air."
    - Peter, Satan is, "your adversary the devil."

  - C. But God commanded light to shine, v. 6; Gen. 1:2-4



"The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: They that dwell in the shadow of death, upon them has the light shined." Isaiah 9:2
