
Eph. 2:15, "[by] abolishing in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, ..." (~RD)

the enmity = the law of commandments ...

vs. 16: "... resulting in the putting to death the enmity" (~RD)







Eph. 2:15, "by abolishing the law of commandments ... that he might create ... Eph. 2:16, "and might reconcile us both to God ..." (~ESV)

#### Two Purposes (answer the question why)

The NEW MAN = THE CHURCH

Col. 3:9, "Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds,

Col. 3:10, "and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him,

Col. 3:11, "where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave nor free, but Christ is all and in all."






