

Eph. 4:5, "one Lord, one faith, one baptism; [God the Son]


Eph. 4:6, "one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all." [God the Father]

"Walking by the Holy Spirit"

The baptism by means of the Holy Spirit is the work of Christ whereby at the moment of faith alone in Christ alone, Christ uses the Holy Spirit to identify the believer with His death, burial, and resurrection and places the believer into the body of Christ, the Church, as the Holy Spirit builds a new temple, which is the body of Christ. (Rom. 6:3–6)

1 Cor. 10:2, "all were baptized into [$\varepsilon i \varsigma$, e i s] Moses in [$\dot{\varepsilon} v$, e n] the cloud and [$\dot{\varepsilon} v$, e n] in the sea,"

Ex. 13:22, "He did not take away the pillar of cloud by day or the pillar of fire by night from before the people." ~NKJV

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
