ἀποτίθημι apotithēmi

aorist middle participle masc plur nom

"to put off, take away; lit. to take off clothes," fig. "to lay aside or put off" the deeds of the flesh, anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, hatred, Col. 3:8. The same word "put off" in vs. 22. The timing of the aorist participle precedes the main verb. τὸ ψεῦδος *to pseudos* <u>THE lie</u> *not* "lying" or "falsehood"

TRUTH = that which is derived from and is consistent with the teaching of God in the 66 Books of the Bible.

The LIE = The devil's worldview.

- Denies the Creator/creature distinction
- Autonomy or independence of the creature
- Antagonism toward God

### What is the Origin of Truth?

1. God is TRUTH!

Psa. 86:15, "But You, O Lord, are a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering and abundant in mercy and truth." Psa. 89:14, "Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; Mercy and truth go before Your face." ### John 8:44 [Jesus speaking to the Pharisees]:

"You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and <u>does not stand in the truth, because there</u> is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it."

### What is THE LIE?

### 1. The Lie is grounded on a rejection of the Creator/ creature or Creator/creation distinction.

<u>Gen. 3:1, "Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of</u> the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, 'Has God indeed said, "You shall not eat of every tree of the garden"?" <u>Gen. 3:4, "Then the serpent said to the woman, 'You will not</u> surely die. <u>Gen. 3:5, "'For God knows that in the day you eat of it your</u> eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.' "

### Satan's claims:

- 1. God did not tell you the truth; God is a liar.
- 2. The creature has the right to judge God's statements.
- 3. The creature has the knowledge to evaluate God's claims.
- 4. The creature thus must be as intelligent and powerful as God and determine his own reality.



## NewAge, Old Lie

### What is THE LIE?

- 1. The Lie is grounded on a rejection of the Creator/ creature or Creator/creation distinction.

<u>Rom. 1:21, "because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him</u> as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened. <u>Rom. 1:22</u>, "Professing to be wise, they became fools, <u>Rom. 1:23, "and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an</u> image made like corruptible man—and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things. Rom. 1:25, "who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen."

### The Lie

**Denies that God**—

- 1. Has the power or knowledge to create ex nihilo.
- 2. Has the power or knowledge to reveal Himself objectively.
- 3. Has the power or knowledge to reveal Himself propositionally or to preserve His revelation.

### The Lie

1. There is no distinction between the Creator and His creation.

2. The Creature cannot know God because:

• God is a liar;

- Humans are smarter than God;
- Humans are equal to God

## Modernism and Postmodernism are two forms of "the Lie" that dominate today.

Modernism: belief that man can use his reason and/or experience to arrive at truth independently of special divine revelation.

Everything including humans derived from a physical, material universe, and thus nothing exists beyond what our senses perceive or our reason can accept.

Humans are self-governing and free to choose their own direction.

Humankind is progressing by using science and reason.

Postmodernism

Humans are cogs in a social machine. We are primarily social beings.

they are self-governing.

Reason, rationality, objective truth is a myth.

"Progress" is a code-word used by modernists to justify the domination by European culture of other cultures.

### People are the product of their culture and only imagine

### In contrast, the Bible teaches:

- Human beings are created in material beings.
- God has granted human beings volition and personal responsibility for the decisions they make.
- God gave man the ability to observe and to reason, but this must be under divine authority given through revelation.
- The fundamental problems of humans since Adam is spiritual death, sin, and depravity. Thus, humans are not progressing toward a glorious, utopic future. Only Christ's death provides an alternative.
