1. We believe the Bible, and only the Bible, has the answer.

<u>2 Pet. 1:3</u>, "as His divine power has given to us <u>all things</u> that pertain <u>to life and godliness</u>, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue,

<u>2 Pet. 1:4</u>, "by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust."

2. Spiritual transformation vs. psychological transformation

Rom. 12:2, "And do not be pressed into the mold of your culture's values and methodology, but be transformed by the total renovation of how and what you think, that your life will be evidence that the will of God (what He says in the Bible) is good and acceptable and (perfect) complete." ~RD paraphrase

<u>Rom. 12:2</u>, "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God." ~NKJV

3. The world system, the spirit of the age, which we refer to as human viewpoint, the way of the flesh, is set in direct conflict with the Word of God. Satan vs. God, human viewpoint vs. Divine viewpoint.







#1 Confession of Sin

- Christ's death on the cross provides the basis for all forgiveness (1 John 1:7).
- Return to the Soul Fortress is based on admission of wrongdoing (1 John 1:9).

"Cleansing" is the key term, experiential recovery from sin.

<u>The basis for cleansing is Christ's completed payment for sin when He died in our place on the cross.</u>

<u>1 John 1:7</u>, "But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin."

The means He uses is our admission of sin to Him.

<u>1 John 1:9</u>, "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."



#2 Filling/Walking "by Means of the Holy Spirit" At salvation, every believer is indwelt and filled by means of the Holy Spirit.

- (1 Cor. 3:11–15).

Whatever is done in the power of the HS is "gold, silver, and precious stones," and has eternal value.

Whatever is done in the power of the sin nature is "wood, hay, and straw" and has no lasting value

#2 Filling/Walking "by Means of the Holy Spirit"

- When we sin, we no longer walk by means of the
- Immediately we are walking according to the sin nature (Rom. 1:1–8; Gal. 5:16–21).
- This restores our walk by the Spirit.

Holy Spirit, we grieve the Holy Spirit (Eph. 4:30).

 Therefore, we must recover our walk by the Spirit and that is admitting our sin to God, confession.

bring to completion the lust of the flesh. <u>Gal. 5:17, "For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit</u> do not do the things that you wish. <u>Gal. 5:19, "Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are:</u> adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, <u>Gal. 5:20, "idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies,</u> outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God."

- against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you
- <u>Gal. 5:18, "But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.</u>
- <u>Gal. 5:21, "envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of</u> which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that

<u>Rom. 8:3, "For what the law could not do in that it was weak</u> through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh, Rom. 8:4, "that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according

to the Spirit.

<u>Rom. 8:5, "For those who live according to the flesh set their minds</u> on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the <u>Spirit, the things of the Spirit.</u>

<u>Rom. 8:6, "For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually</u> minded is life and peace.

<u>Rom. 8:7, "Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is</u> not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. Rom. 8:8, "So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God."

Eph. 4:30, "And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption."

#2 Filling/Walking "by Means of the Holy Spirit"

- God the Holy Spirit is the divine empowerment to:... understand, retain, remember, and apply doctrine
- ... understand, retain, rem (Col. 3:16)
- ... produce spiritual growth (<u>Eph. 5:18; Col. 3:16;</u> Gal. 5:16 w/ John 15:1–6)
- ... enable our spiritual gift (1 Cor. 12; <u>Eph. 4:7</u>)

#2 Filling/Walking "by Means of the Holy Spirit"

<u>Eph. 5:18</u>, "And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but <u>be filled with [*by means of*]</u> the Spirit, <u>Eph. 5:19</u>, "speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord," ~NKJV

<u>Col. 3:16</u>, "Let the word of Christ richly <u>dwell within you</u>, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God."

Gal. 5:16, "But I say, walk by [means of] the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh."
