

<u>Deut. 6:6</u>, "'<u>And these words</u> which I command you today shall be <u>in your heart</u>.'"





What is doctrine?

διδαχή didachē (30× New Testament; 13× Gospels/Acts) teaching, instruction

Acts 2:42, "And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, that is in the breaking of bread, and in prayers."

2 Tim. 4:2, "Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching."

<u>Titus 1:9</u>, "holding fast the faithful word as he has been taught, that he may be able, by <u>sound doctrine</u>, both to exhort and convict those who contradict."

Eph. 4:11, "And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, Eph. 4:12, "for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, Eph. 4:12, "till we all come to the unity of the faith and of

#### Modern War Institute:

"According to the old FM 3-0, doctrine consists of a) fundamental principles, b) <u>tactics</u>, <u>techniques</u>, and <u>procedures</u>, and c) terms and symbols."

- Aligning our thinking to the reality of God's Word, creation, and plan.
- The teaching of God's Word must become a way of life, not just something else we do.
- The teaching of God's Word includes the entire realm of Biblical teaching, from the abstract to the intensely practical.
- God's Word teaches us how to think, how to react, how to problem solve, how to prioritize, how to relate to the world, the systems, the people, and the circumstances of life.

2 Pet. 3:18, "but grow [by means of] the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ."

ץ בַּחָ (ḥāpēṣ) I, take delight in, be pleased with, desire

קּגְה (hāgâ) I, utter, mutter, moan (mourn ~KJV), meditate, devise, plot

Psa. 119:10, "With my whole heart I have sought You; Oh, let me not wander from Your commandments!

John 17:17, "Set them apart for your service by means of Your truth. Your Word is truth." [RD]

Rom. 12:1, "I exhort [challenge] you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy [set apart], acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. [RD]

Rom. 12:2, "And do not be pressured to conform to the thinking, talking, and actions of those in the pagan way of life around you, but be transformed by the renovation of your thinking, that you may demonstrate that God's will is good and acceptable and complete." [RD]
