

FULFILLMENT:

Matt. 1:18, "... After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit."

PROPHET Fulfillment

UNFULFILLED PROPHECY

Daniel's Seventy Week Prophecy

Daniel wanted information about the end of the Babylonian captivity. God gave him an answer that goes all the way to the 2nd coming of Christ.



The subject of the prophecy is ISRAEL, *not* the Church – "your people", "your holy city" Jer. 29:10, "For thus says the LORD, 'When <u>seventy years</u> have been completed for Babylon, I will visit you and fulfill My good word to you, to bring you back to this place.'" Jer. 25:11, " 'And this whole land shall be a desolation and a horror, and these nations shall serve the king of Babylon <u>seventy</u> years.

Jer. 25:12, " 'Then it will be when <u>seventy</u> years are completed I will punish the king of Babylon and that nation,' declares the LORD, 'for their iniquity, and the land of the Chaldeans; and I will make it an everlasting desolation.' " Dan. 9:24, "Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sin, to make atonement for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most holy place.

Dan. 9:25, "So you are to know and discern that from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince there will be seven weeks and sixtytwo weeks; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress." Dan. 9:26, "Then after the sixty-two weeks the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. And its end will come with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.

The Entire 70 Weeks (Dan. 9:24)

The Chronology What are the 70 "weeks"?

Seventy units of seven "weeks" = shabu'im 70 × 7 = 70 Weeks of Years (490 years)

Lev. 26:34, "Then the land shall enjoy its sabbaths as long as it lies desolate and you *are* in your enemies' land; then the land shall rest and enjoy its sabbaths.

Lev. 26:35, "As long as *it* lies desolate it shall rest—for the time it did not rest on your sabbaths when you dwelt in it."

6 Things That Will be Accomplished

- 1. "To finish the transgression" (rebellion of Israel)
- 2. "To make an end of sin"
- 3. "To atone for iniquity" (sin will be totally dealt with)
 - 4. "To bring in everlasting righteousness"
- 5. "To seal up vision and prophecy" (terminate/fulfill prophecy)
- 6. "To anoint the most holy place"

The First 69 Weeks (Dan. 9:25)

The Commencement

If the 70 weeks refer to 490 years, all we have to do is find the starting point.

4 Decrees:

- 1. Decree of Cyrus (Oct. 29, 539 B.C., Ezra 1:1-4; 5:13)
- 2. Decree of Darius (519/18 B.C., Ezra 6:1-12)
- 3. Decree of Artaxerxes Longimanus to Ezra (457 B.C.)
- 4. <u>Decree of Artaxerxes Longimanus to Nehemiah</u> (<u>March 5, 444 B.C., Nehemiah 2:1-8</u>) <u>Direct</u> reference to restore the city, walls, and gates

The Completion of the 69 Weeks When did it end?

March 30, A.D. 33 (4 days before the death of Jesus)

The Gap Between the 69th and 70th Weeks (Dan. 9:26)


There is a gap of at least 37 years between the end of the 69^{th} week and beginning of the 70^{th} week. In this gap two specific events occurred. (70 - 33 = 37) Dan. 9:26, "Then after the sixty-two weeks the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary [AD 70]. And its end will come with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.

Rationale for 360-Day Years

- Half week—Daniel 9:27
- **Time, times, half a time** Daniel 7:25, 12:7; Rev. 12:14
- 1,260 days—Revelation 12:6, 11:3
- 42 months—Revelation 11:2, 13:5
- Thus: 42 months = 1,260 days = time, times, half a time + half week
- Therefore: month = 30 days; year = 360 days

Explanation of Daniel's 70 Weeks of Years

- 69 × 7 × 360 = 173,880 days
- March 5, 444 B.C. + 173,880 = March 30, A.D. 33


Verification

• 444 B.C. to A.D. 33 -1 (no year 0) = 476 years

• 476 years × 365.2421989 days = 173,855 days
 + days between March 5 and March 30 = 25 days



3. A Jewish Temple

The 70th Week of Israel

The 70 weeks concern the nation of Israel – God's program for Israel. When the Jews rejected Jesus, God interrupted His program with Israel with this present Church Age between the 69th and 70th weeks. After the Rapture, God will resume His dealings with Israel for one week of years.

Since the first 69 weeks of years were literally fulfilled, we should expect for the final or 70th week to be literally fulfilled as well.
