

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

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

- 1. Description of the anointed cherub from his creation, Ezek. 28:12–15a.
 - a. The seal of perfection,
 - b. Located in Eden, the garden of God.
 - c. Adorned with jewels similar to Israel's high priest
 - d. The anointed cherub who covers
 - e. Created by God, not born, bara, designates a direct divine creation.

 - a. Abundance of trade, Ezek. 28:16a
 - b. Mental attitude sins of arrogance, violence, sin. Ezek. 28:16b–17
