
Traditional View: Jesus is Brought to Pilate at the Antonia Fortress




More Accurate View: Jesus is Brought to Pilate at Herod's Palace




שער "הנעלם" הבואבה "المخفية" Gate "Hidden"

הסור העות'מאני מחکم האغلاق, لكن الدرجات المجاورة له تفشي سرا: انها تشير الى بوابه او مدخل صغير كان موجودا في السور من ايام الهيكل الثاني. قاد هذا المدخل على ما يبدو الى قصر هيرودس الذي بني بقربه.

The Ottoman city wall is sealed, but the steps adjacent to it reveal a secret: they allude to the existence of a gate or postern in the city wall from the time of the Second Temple. Presumably this gate led to Herod's palace, which was located nearby.





THE FIRST SAYING

Luke 23:33, “And when they came to the place called The Skull, there they crucified Him and the criminals, one on the right and the other on the left.


Luke 23:34, “But Jesus was saying, ‘Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing.’ ”



Luke 23:35, “And the people stood by, looking on.”





Luke 23:39, “And one of the criminals who were hanged there was hurling abuse at Him, saying, ‘Are You not the Christ? Save Yourself and us!’”


Luke 23:40, “But the other answered, and rebuking him said, ‘Do you not even fear God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation?’ ”

THE THIRD SAYING



Luke 23:45a, “the sun being obscured;”




THE FOURTH SAYING



Luke 23:45c, “and the veil of the temple was torn in two.”




THE SIXTH SAYING

Luke 23:46, “And Jesus, crying out with a loud voice, said, ‘Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit.’ Having said this, He breathed His last.”
