Gen. 16:13, “Then she called the name of the LORD who spoke to her, You–Are–the–God–Who–Sees; for she said, ‘Have I also here seen Him who sees me?’ ”

Gen. 48:16, “The Angel who has redeemed me from all evil, bless the lads; Let my name be named upon them, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; And let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.”

Ex. 3:2, “And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush was not consumed.

Ex. 3:3, “Then Moses said, ‘I will now turn aside and see this great sight, why the bush does not burn.’”

Ex. 3:4, “So when the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, ‘Moses, Moses!’ And he said, ‘Here I am.’”

Judg. 6:11, “Now the Angel of the LORD came and sat under the terebinth tree which was in Ophrah, which belonged to Joash the Abiezrite, while his son Gideon threshed wheat in the winepress, in order to hide it from the Midianites.

Judg. 6:12, “And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him, and said to him, ‘The LORD is with you, you mighty man of valor!’

Judg. 6:13, “Gideon said to Him, ‘O my lord, if the LORD is with us, why then has all this happened to us? And where are all His miracles which our fathers told us about, saying, “Did not the LORD bring us up from Egypt?” But now the LORD has forsaken us and delivered us into the hands of the Midianites.’ ”

Judg. 6:14, “Then the LORD turned to him and said, ‘Go in this might of yours, and you shall save Israel from the hand of the Midianites. Have I not sent you?’

Judg. 6:15, “So he said to Him, ‘O my Lord, how can I save Israel? Indeed my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father’s house.’

Judg. 6:16, “And the LORD said to him, ‘Surely I will be with you, and you shall defeat the Midianites as one man.’ ”

Judg. 13:15, “Then Manoah said to the Angel of the LORD, ‘Please let us detain You, and we will prepare a young goat for You.’”

Judg. 13:16, “And the Angel of the LORD said to Manoah, ‘Though you detain Me, I will not eat your food. But if you offer a burnt offering, you must offer it to the LORD.’ (For Manoah did not know He was the Angel of the LORD.)”

Why Gilgal?

Ex. 14:19, “And the Angel of God, who went before the camp of Israel, moved and went behind them; and the pillar of cloud went from before them and stood behind them.”

Ex. 23:20, “Behold, I send an Angel before you to keep you in the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared.”


Ex. 33:14, “And He said, ‘My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest.’

Ex. 23:24, “You shall not bow down to their gods, nor serve them, nor do according to their works; but you shall utterly overthrow them and completely break down their sacred pillars.”

Ex. 23:32, “You shall make no covenant with them, nor with their gods.

Ex. 23:33, “They shall not dwell in your land, lest they make you sin against Me. For if you serve their gods, it will surely be a snare to you.”

Deut. 7:2, “and when the LORD your God delivers them over to you, you shall conquer them and utterly destroy them. You shall make no covenant with them nor show mercy [*chesed*] to them.

Deut. 7:3, “Nor shall you make marriages with them. You shall not give your daughter to their son, nor take their daughter for your son.”

About**

God's Faithfulness



1. God was faithful to His promise to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. He rescued them from Egypt, brought them into the land, and gave them victory.

Deut. 7:9, “Therefore know that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments;”

Old Testament

Psa. 36:5, “Your mercy, O LORD, is in the heavens; Your faithfulness reaches to the clouds.”

Psa. 37:3, “Trust in the LORD, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.”

BUT

Psa. 78:37, “For their heart was not steadfast with Him, nor were they faithful in His covenant.”

Psa. 89:2, “For I have said, ‘Mercy shall be built up forever; Your faithfulness You shall establish in the very heavens.’ ”

Psa. 89:5, “And the heavens will praise Your wonders, O LORD; Your faithfulness also in the assembly of the saints.”

Psa. 89:8, “O LORD God of hosts, who is mighty like You, O LORD? Your faithfulness also surrounds You.”

Psa. 89:24, “ ‘But My faithfulness and My mercy shall be with him, and in My name his horn shall be exalted.’ ”

Psa. 89:33, “ ‘Nevertheless My lovingkindness I will not utterly take from him, nor allow My faithfulness to fail.’ ”

Psa. 89:37, “ ‘It shall be established forever like the moon, even like the faithful witness in the sky.’ Selah”

Heb. 11:11, “By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised.”

1 John 1:9, “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

**1 Thess. 5:24, “He who calls you is faithful,
who also will do it.”**

1 Cor. 1:9, “God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.”

1 Cor. 10:13, “No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.”

**2 Tim. 2:11, “This is a faithful saying:
For if we died with Him, [and we did, Rom.
6:2–6]**

We shall also live with Him.

**2 Tim. 2:12, “If we endure,
