

- 2 Cor. 6:14, "Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness?
- 2 Cor. 6:15, "And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever?
- 2 Cor. 6:16, "And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: 'I will dwell in them and walk among them. I will be their God, and they shall be My people.'"

Judg. 2:7, "So the people served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders who outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of the LORD which He had done for Israel."

Judg. 2:12, "and they abandoned ["forsook" NKJV] the LORD God of their fathers, who had brought them out of the land of Egypt; and they followed other gods from among the gods of the people who were all around them, and they bowed down to them; and they provoked the LORD to anger."

Judges 3:6, "And they took their daughters for themselves as wives, and gave their own daughters to their sons,"

The Consequences of Historical "Forgetting" or Cancelling the Past!

1. An act of negative volition, a willful, intentional forgetting and choosing Baal and Asherah, the creation/nature gods, over the Creator God, Suzerain over all the earth who has entered into covenant with them.

2. Thus this is an act of treason toward the Suzerain and punishable by extreme measures.

3. To do this psychologically, they must enter into some sort of self-deceptive delusion about history.
