Shoah

The Hebrew word of Biblical origins which has been used to mean "destruction" or "catastrophe". This has become the standard Hebrew term for the murder of European Jewry as early as the early 1940s.



Holocaust

The word *Holocaust*, which came into use in the 1950s, comes from the Greek word "holos" meaning whole and "Kauustos" meaning a sacrificial offering burned on an altar.



Genocide

Genocide is the intentional action to destroy an ethnic, national, racial, or religious group in whole or in part. It is a hybrid word of Greek origin "Geno", meaning race or people, and "cide", meaning the act of killing. The term was coined by Raphael Lemkin – a Polish Jewish lawyer living in post-war America in his 1944 book "Axis Rule in Occupied Europe."




SHOAH

The Holocaust was unprecedented genocide, total and systematic, perpetrated by Nazi Germany and its collaborators, with the aim of annihilating the Jewish people. The primary motivation was the Nazis' antisemitic racist ideology. Between 1933 and 1941 Nazi Germany pursued a policy that dispossessed the Jews of their rights and their property, followed by the branding and concentration of the Jewish population. This policy gained broad support in Germany and much of occupied Europe. In 1941, following the invasion of the Soviet Union, the Nazis and their collaborators launched the systematic mass murder of the Jews. By 1945 nearly six million Jews had been murdered.



Nuremberg Laws




The passage of the Nuremberg Laws by the Reichstag on September 15, 1935, was the first direct attack on individual rights of Jews in Germany. These laws mark a sharp progression toward an irreversible anti-Semitic policy.

Anti – Jewish Laws 1935-36



Jews prohibited from work in the government. Can only attend Jewish schools. The practice of business, law, or medicine is not allowed. Cannot teach or work in journalism. Excluded from movies, theaters, concerts. Can only use Jewish-owned shops. Can no longer swim or engage in sports.



KRISTALLNACHT

November 1938

"Night of broken glass," anti-Jewish riots broke out in areas under Nazi influence.


Violence was committed against Jewish people and property by the non-Jewish population.

Anti-Jewish Laws of 1939



Ability to leave the country was restricted.

Banned from public trains.

Can no longer drive cars.

Can only shop between 3 pm-5 pm.

Cannot be out after 8 pm.

Can no longer visit Christians.

Anti-Jewish Laws of 1941

All Jews over 6 years of age must wear a yellow Star of David at all times.



Wannsee Conference



On January 20, 1942, a meeting was held in Wannsee (a suburb of Berlin)

Wannsee Conference



The conference, called by Chief of the Reich Main Security Office, Reinhard Heydrich, was attended by representatives from several government ministries, including state secretaries from the Foreign Office, the Justice, Interior, and State Ministries, and representatives from the Schutzstaffel (SS).





The Wannsee Conference was a meeting of senior officials of Nazi Germany,

Engineering mass murder



In the summer of 1941, Rudolf Höss commander of the Auschwitz-Birkenau concentration camp had received orders to explore new methods of mass murder using poison gas.




The elderly and women with children were sent directly to the line of prisoners who were **condemned** to death in the gas chambers.



Auschwitz liberated on January 27th, 1945 by the Red Army.

I made the visit deliberately, in order to be in a position to give first-hand evidence of these things if ever, in the future, there develops a tendency to charge these allegations merely to "propaganda."

Under orders from General Eisenhower, Members of the U.S. Army Signal Corps recorded approximately 80,000 feet of moving film, together with still photographs.





Why is it important we never forget?

- Witnesses passing away. (Covid)



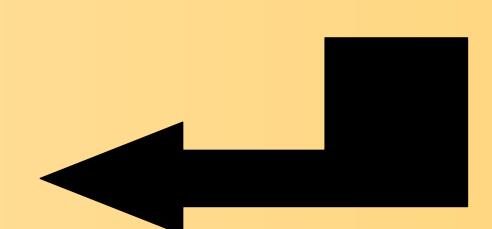
