Gen. 1:1


"In the beginning, God created..."

"To create **things** and to create **events** is to create **time**, and for God **to create time** He must be **independent of time**."


Categories of Time

- Duration the time that something lasts.
- Tense the time an event occurs.
- Distance the time it takes to get somewhere.
