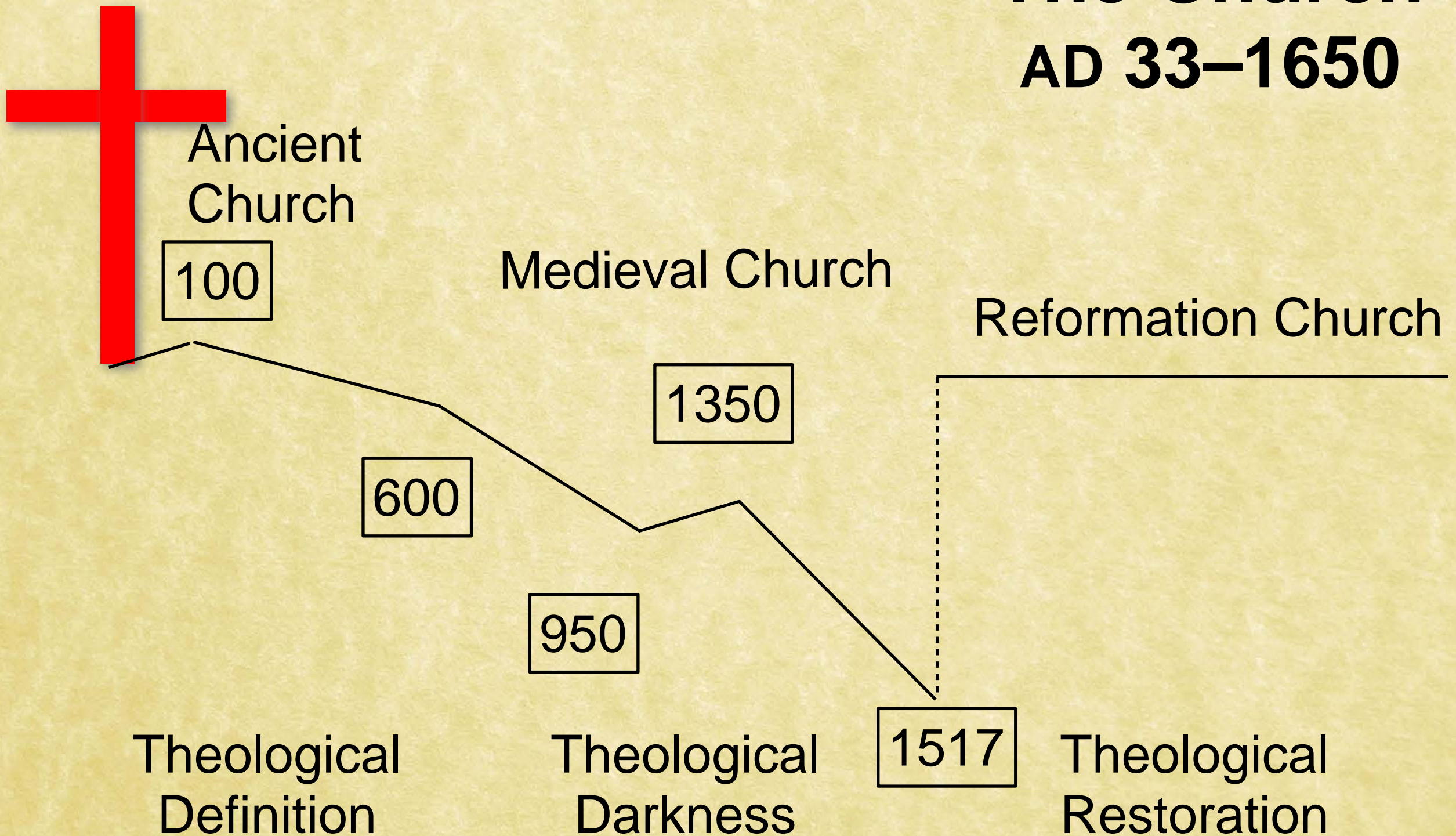

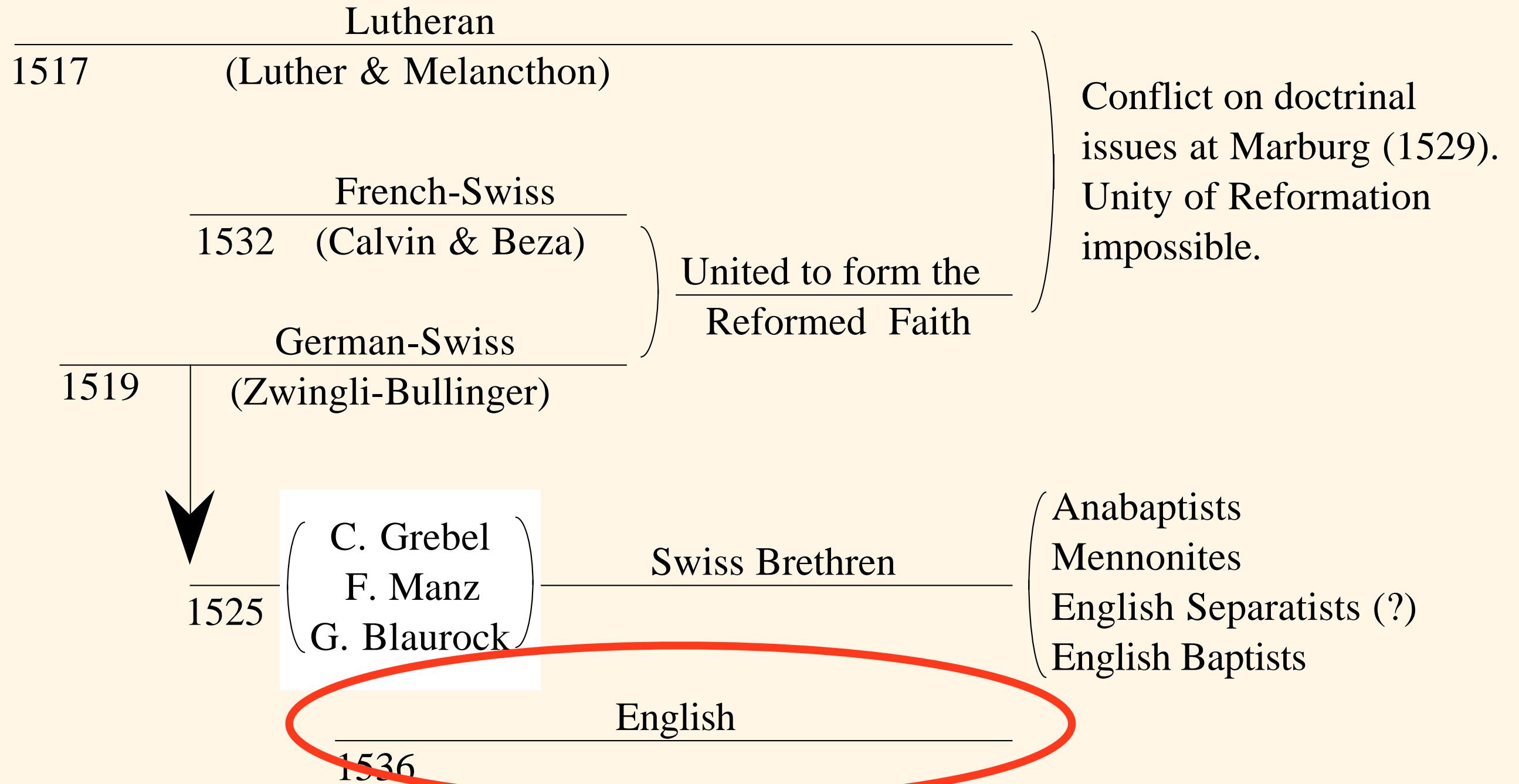

**Hugh Latimer (1487–16 October 1555)**

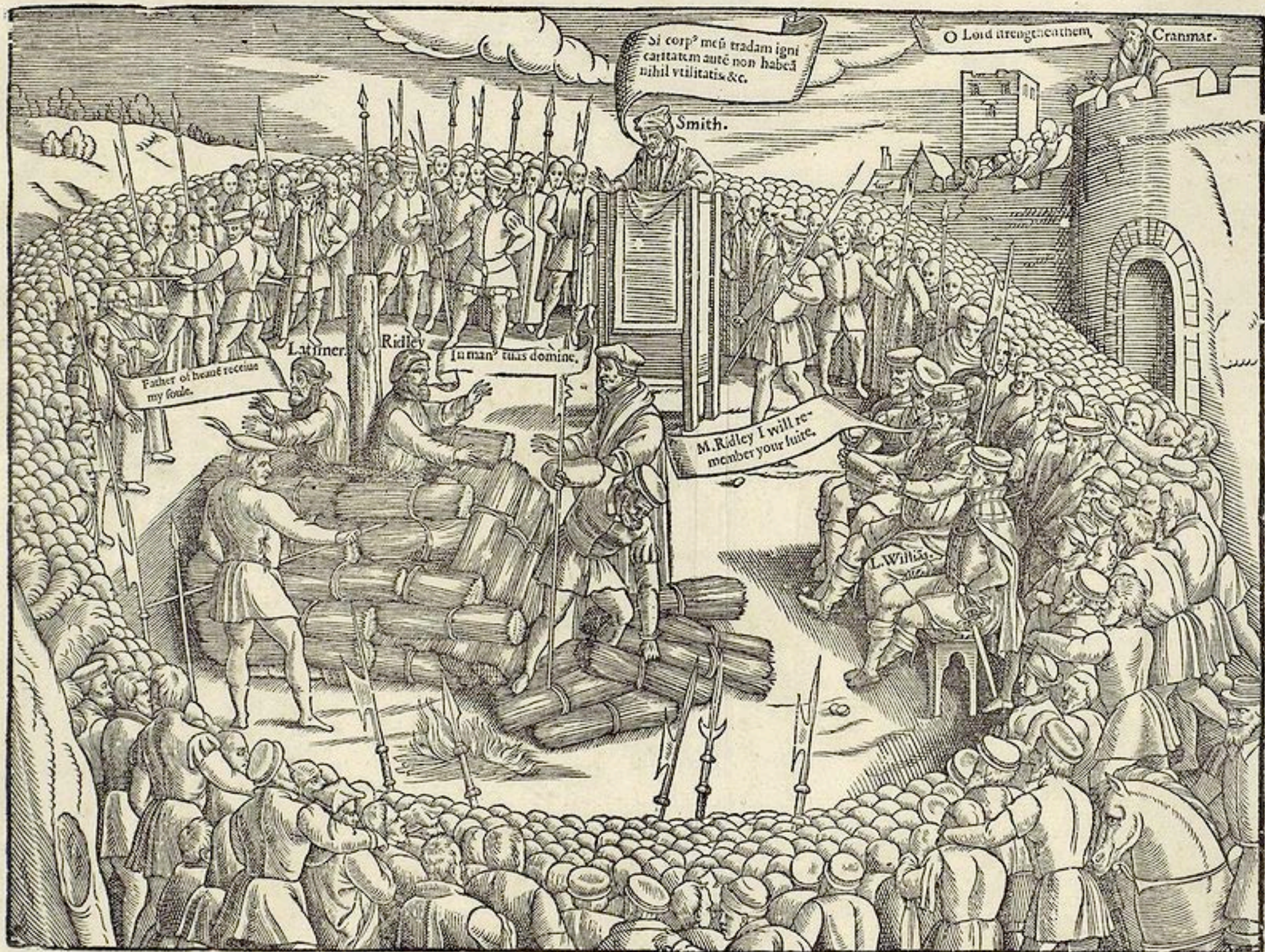


“Latimer before the Council”, from an 1887 edition of [Foxe's \*Book of Martyrs\*](#), illustrated by Kronheim.

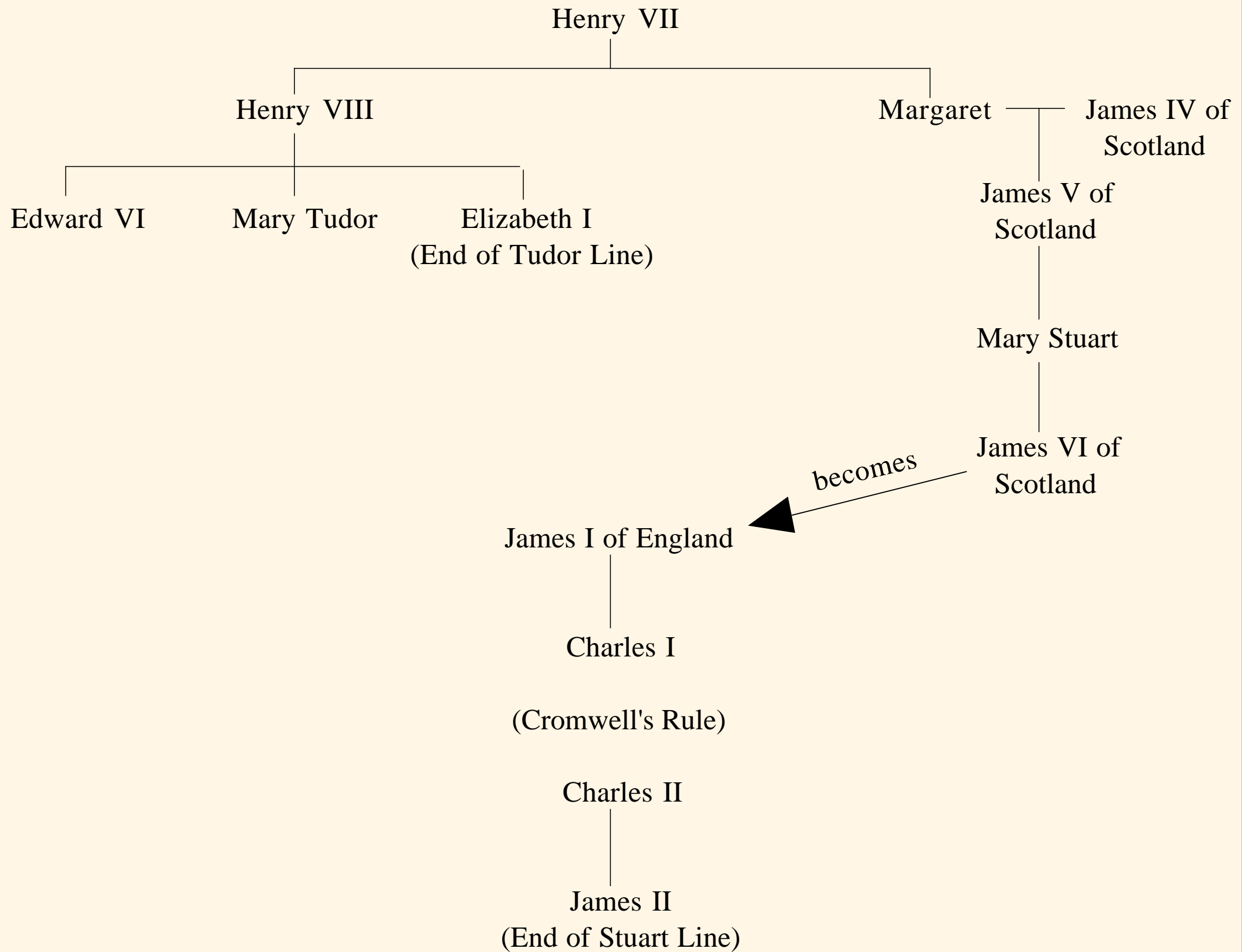

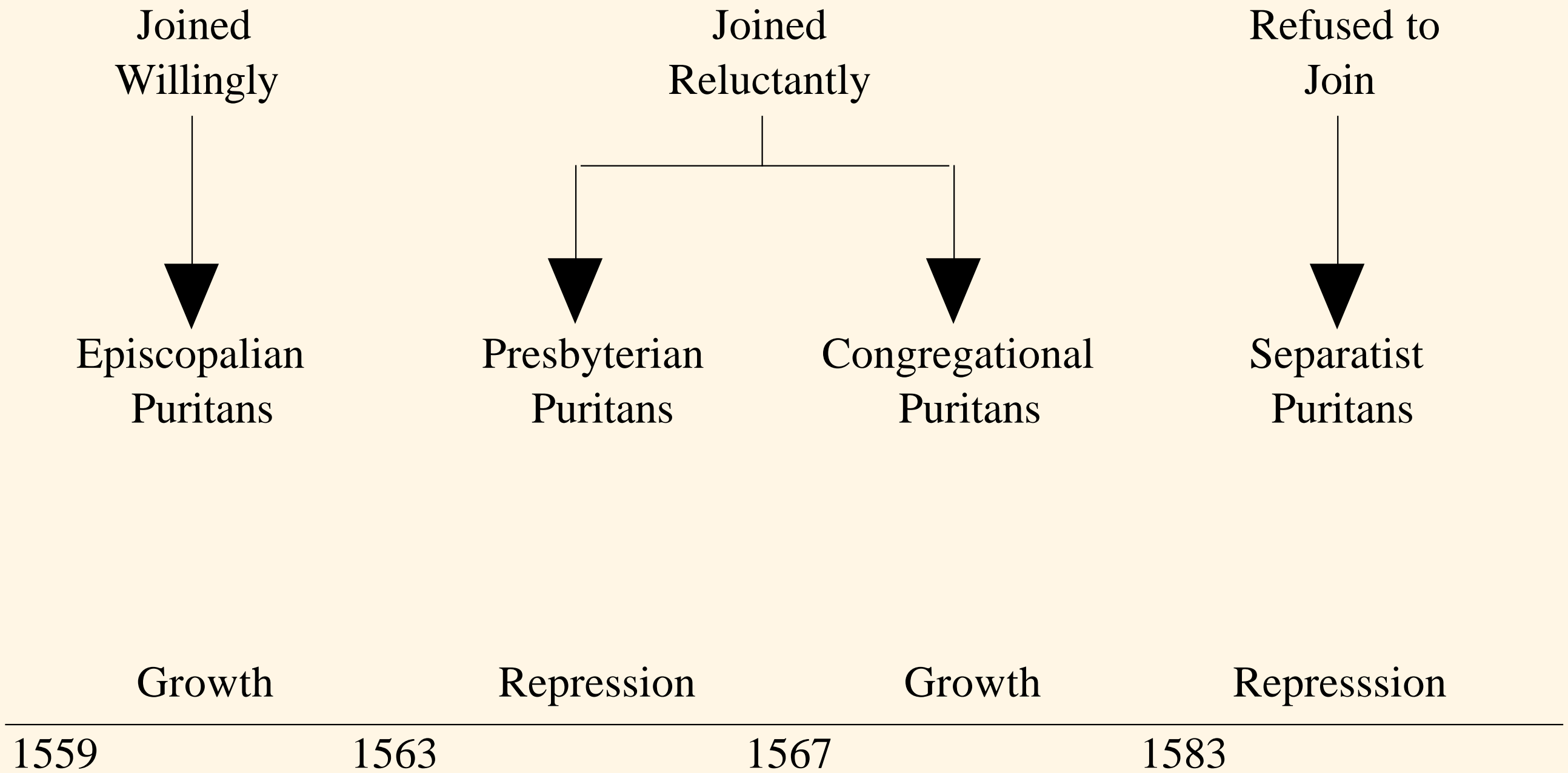
