

Holding Fast to God's Word Philippians 2:12–16



<u>Php. 2:12</u>, "Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, <u>work</u> out your own <u>salvation</u> with fear and trembling;" [NKJV]

κατεργάζομαι *katergazomai* 2 plur pres mid impera to produce something

σωτηρία *sōtēria* fem sing acc salvation, deliverance

The first command: Work out your deliverance (Phase 2)

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Three Stages of Salvation

PHASE ONE Justification

Saved from **Penalty of Sin**

"you were saved"

"you are being saved"

PHASE TWO

Spiritual Life

PHASE THREE Glorification

Saved from **Power of Sin**

Saved from **Presence of Sin**

"you will be saved"

<u>Php. 1:27</u>, "Only let the way you <u>live your life be worthy</u> of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel," [RD]

πολιτεύομαι politeuomai

2 plur pres mid impera live as a citizen. In Koine Greek it had become an idiom for *how someone lived their life*. cf., Eph. 2:19 ἀξίως *axiōs* adverb: in a worthy manner; worthily, in a manner worthy of, suitably, deserving effort

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στήκω stēkō 2 plur pres act indic stand firm; BDAG: ② to be firmly committed in conviction or belief

In Ephesians 4:

In Philippians 2

- 3. Working hard to maintain the unity of the Spirit. "Nothing through self-centeredness," only in humility; Php. 2:3
- 4. There is one body, one Spirit, "just as you were called in one hope of your calling." "Let this mind be in you which was in Christ."
