

Five Lessons We Learn From the Global Flood

Five Lessons	The Global Flood
1. Grace before judgment	120 year grace periodEnoch warnedNoah warned
2. Who to save, who to judge	Saved: Those in the arkJudged: Those outside the ark
3. Only one way of salvation	Only one ark designed by God and it had only one door.
4. The world changed	The global flood changed the whole world.
5. How to be saved: by faith	Noah was saved because he trusted God.

Second Divine Institution: Marriage

Is this the first covenant God made with mankind?

It is the first use of the the word covenant, but not the first use of the covenantal language.

Initial Commands and Promises (Creation Covenant)

Gen. 1:28: Five commands (5 responsibilities)
Be fruitful and multiply, fill the earth and subdue it.
Have dominion

Gen. 2:15: Tend and keep the Garden.

Gen 1:29: I have given you every herb and every tree for food, except the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

Gen 2:16, "you may freely eat of every tree of the garden, except one."

Gen 2:23: God made the woman to help the man because he couldn't do it alone.

How the Creation Covenant was Modified to the Adamic Covenant

- 1. The man was to serve in the garden, now the soil is hostile.
- 2. The man's responsibilities have become burdensome.
- 3. The woman designed to assist, now desires control.
- 4. Painless procreation become painful labor.
- 5. The animal kingdom is affected.



Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, Gen. 9:1

The animals will have dread of humans, Gen. 9:2

Every moving thing will be food, Gen. 9:3


Don't eat the animals alive, Gen. 9:5

Murderers shall be executed, delegation of civil judgments, Gen. 9:6

Hos. 6:7, "But like Adam, you broke my covenant and betrayed my trust." [NLT]

- Noah and all his descendants,
- All mankind, and
- Animals (unlike future covenants, this New World Covenant includes all animals).


2. The Signing of the New World Covenant

Gen. 9:12, "And God said: 'This is the sign of the covenant which I make between Me and you, and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations:

Gen. 9:13, " 'I set My rainbow in the cloud, and it shall be for the sign of the covenant between Me and the earth.

Gen. 9:14, " 'It shall be, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the rainbow shall be seen in the cloud;

Gen. 9:15, "'and I will remember My covenant which is between Me and you and every living creature of all flesh; the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all flesh.'"







Ezek. 1:28, "Like the appearance of a rainbow in a cloud on a rainy day, so was the appearance of the brightness all around it. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. So when I saw it, I fell on my face, and I heard a voice of One speaking."

Rev. 4:3, "And He who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance; and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald."

Gen. 2:5, "before any plant of the field was in the earth and before any herb of the field had grown. For the LORD God had not caused it to rain on the earth, and there was no man to till the ground;

Gen. 2:6, "but a mist went up from the earth and watered the whole face of the ground."

Rom. 1:18, "For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,


Rom. 1:19, "because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them.





Psa. 29:10, "The LORD sat enthroned at the Flood, and the LORD sits as King forever."



Signatories (the one who s	God alone (with the rainbow)
Promises	No future global floods
Type of Covenant	Unconditional (God will keep His promise. It is not dependent on anything or anyone else.)
